NAAIC's mentorship has provided more than just curriculum guidance, it's been transformational. Through hands-on training with Intel and AWS, participation in the National AI Conference, and regular mentorship meetings, our faculty have gained the tools and confidence to build a future-ready AI program. Monthly touchpoints with our mentor and the NAAIC team ensured we stayed on track and had the support needed to move forward.

The mentorship also helped us strengthen outreach and industry engagement. We launched a Business and Industry Leadership Team focused on AI, which has been vital in aligning our curriculum with workforce needs. With input from peers and regional stakeholders, ICC is now preparing to submit our AAS in AI for approval, aiming to launch in Fall 2026.
