

Children's Code of Conduct Activity

Step 1: Have a conversation with children in your ministry (e.g. youth group, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Children's Liturgy)

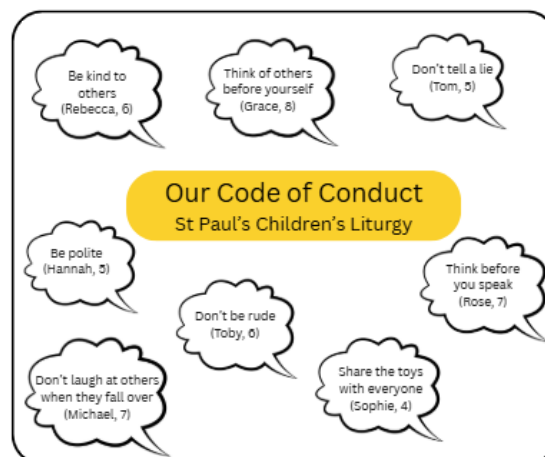
Ask the Children questions such as:

- What do you like about coming here? How can we make sure everyone else feels like that?
- What makes you feel appreciated by others?
- What makes you feel safe and supported here?
- What makes you happy here?
- How does it make you feel when someone does ____ for you? (e.g. when Anne shares the pencils with you?)
- How can we love others like Jesus loves us?

Step 2: Create a Code of Conduct Poster

Collect the children's thoughts and ideas to the questions/conversation above, then:

- Put together a Code of Conduct Poster using the children's thoughts and ideas
- An example poster could look like this:



- Decorate the poster with the children
- Explain that these things on the poster are the ways we can make sure everyone feels support and enjoy their time in the group.
- Put up the poster in the room where the ministry takes place (e.g. classroom, Church Hall)
