Miscellaneous Property Floater

Perils Insured

All risks of direct physical loss or damage to the described property from any external cause, except as hereinafter provided.

Perils Excluded - loss or damage caused directly or indirectly by or resulting from:

1. earthquake, except for ensuing physical loss or damage which results directly from fire, explosion, smoke or leakage from fire protective equipment
2. flood
3. centrifugal force, mechanical or electrical breakdown or derangement in or on the premises unless fire ensues and then only for the loss or damage caused directly by such ensuing fire;
4. dampness or dryness of atmosphere, changes of temperature, contamination, freezing, heating, shrinkage, evaporation, loss of weight, leakage of contents, exposure to light, change in colour or texture or finish, rust or corrosion, marring, scratching or crushing
5. smoke from agricultural smudging or industrial operations
6. rodents, insects or vermin
7. delay, loss of market or loss of use or occupancy
8. any dishonest or criminal act on Your part or any other party of interest, Your employees or agents, or any person to whom the property may be entrusted
9. wear and tear, gradual deterioration, latent defect, inherent vice, or the cost of making good faulty or improper material, faulty or improper workmanship, faulty or improper design
10. mysterious disappearance or shortage of equipment or stock disclosed on taking inventory
11. loss or damage sustained to equipment or stock while actually being worked upon and directly resulting therefrom or caused by any repairing, adjusting or servicing of equipment or stock
