James, a patient of Good Samaritan Clinic for three years, experienced three major strokes, several small strokes, two open heart surgeries and a mechanical valve replacement. He lost his job and his insurance, so he couldn't afford to pay for his medications and doctor visits. James explains, "I'm a manual labor person, so I haven't worked since 2015. An employer is not going to hire me because of my health problems."

Since coming to Good Samaritan, James has been able to get the care he needs. "If I had to pay out of pocket, my medications would be \$1,000 to \$1,500 a month. If I don't have the medications, my heart will quit beating, the valve will quit working."

What would the uninsured in our community do without Good Samaritan Clinic?



Survey results show majority of our patients come to the clinic by "word-of-mouth" due to a referral of a friend, family member, or another patient of the clinic.



Special Ways You Can Support Good Samaritan's Mission:

- 1. Pray for Our Efforts Pray that God would continue to supply the necessary resources for the clinic to continue its mission and that we would be a blessing to the patients we care for each day.
