Good Samaritan - Beyond a Free Clinic

I look forward to when I can return to work and give back to the community that contributed to my care.

George had low expectations when he was referred to Good Samaritan Clinic.

He once lived in Florida and had taken some people to a local migrant clinic for assistance, but they barely did anything to help and left them feeling less than worthy of assistance.

What George experienced at Good Samaritan was very different. He walked into Good Samaritan with low expectations and walked out totally amazed. "The staff are so supportive of each other and the people they help. I realized quickly that I had underestimated, and you over delivered."

She took the time to listen.

When George came to GSHC in July 2023, he couldn't walk, had difficulty breathing, and had numerous other health concerns, some diagnosed, others still to be identified. Since coming to Good Samaritan, he says the Clinic has been "rebuilding a broken body." He credits the Nurse (Patricia Calvert, CRNP) for the progress he has made. "Ms. Calvert took the time to listen to everything I said. She diagnosed me with hypertension, high cholesterol, and was able to get me glasses so I could read and drive. I had severe pain in my shoulder, and others had said it was arthritis. She really listened to what I was saying



and made the correct diagnosis. She referred me to UAB where I had a complete shoulder replacement."

Now, in less than one week's post op, George's range of motion has already improved. He is well on his way to healing and feeling much better. During his journey through diagnosis and healing, he decided to make the most of his down time and took a four-week

course to earn his CDL. George says, "I look forward to when I can return to work and give back to the community that contributed to my care. You guys are beyond a free clinic."

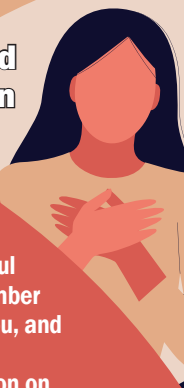

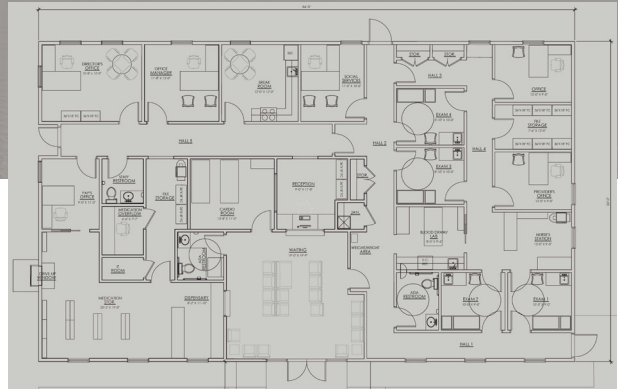

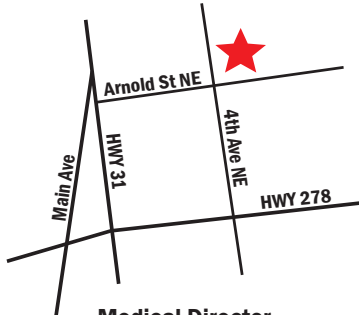
