From Despair to Hope: A Future Begins at the Clinic

When the pain became too much to bear, Adam found more than medical care—he found a second chance.

Adam had worked in construction for over 30 years, enduring blistering heat and biting cold without complaint. But in June 2023, a small bump on his ear began to grow uncontrollably. As the months passed, the pain worsened—especially in the heat—and eventually, working became impossible.

“I was going around trying to find help, but no one would help me because I didn’t have insurance,” Adam recalled. “It wasn’t until I went to the Cullman County Health Department that a lady at the front desk told me about Good Samaritan Health Clinic.”

That one referral changed everything.

Adam first came to GSHC in July 2024. He was seen by our compassionate Nurse Practitioner who quickly recognized the urgency of his condition.

The clinic helped him get referred to UAB Dermatology, where, after months of waiting, he finally had surgery. The diagnosis: Stage 4 cancer. Surgeons removed his ear and several lymph nodes.

“If it wasn’t for Good Samaritan, I don’t think I’d be here,” Adam said. “They got

me the help no one else would. They really saved me.”

Today, Adam is recovering and hopeful. He has a good prognosis and is looking forward to returning to work—perhaps through sub-contracting since his former employer can no longer hire him due to his health history.

Adam’s story is a powerful reminder of what’s possible when compassion meets action.

We are thrilled to announce that our new facility project will be open for bids very soon! We invite general contractors, especially those local to the Cullman area, to submit their proposals for this important project.



Project Details:

The new facility will be a 5,040-square-foot building situated on 2.7 acres in the southwest part of the City of Cullman, at 118 Veterans Drive SW. Thoughtfully designed to meet the evolving needs of our community, the building will include four exam rooms, a spacious waiting area that doubles as a meeting space for after-hours patient education classes, a medication dispensary with drive-thru access, a lab, and a cardio room. This will be a place where everyone feels welcome and cared for. At the heart of our mission is a commitment to ensure that all patients are met with compassion and

served by some of the most experienced health professionals in the community.
