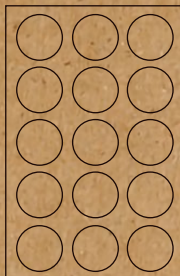

craft instructions

Here's how it works:

1. Enjoy your tea – of course in your brandnew tea cup.
2. Take out the rest of the contents from the box.
3. Place the soil pellets on the bottom of the box. Slowly pour small amounts of water over them until they are fully expanded. Please note: the wooden box is not 100% waterproof and may absorb water. Depending on where you place it, you may want to put something underneath.
4. Plant the clover seeds in the individual soil cylinders according to the instructions.
5. Break out the little markers from the lid and label your seeds so you remember what's growing where.
6. Place the box in a nice spot – for example, on your balcony. Make sure it gets enough sunlight, but protect the delicate seedlings from heavy rain and overwatering.
7. Wait and watch as the small plants slowly grow and thrive.



May your clover grow strong and full – rooted in the rich Irish tradition where the three-leaf shamrock was used by St. Patrick to symbolize the Holy Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. While the common shamrock stands as a proud symbol of Ireland, the rare four-leaf clover – found in only about 1 in 5,000 – holds its own magic: each leaf represents faith, hope, love, and luck.

To give your luck a little boost, we've tucked in a bit of lucky clover – may you spot that rare fourth leaf and carry a touch of timeless fortune with you.
