



# Dangerous Chemicals on Farms

## Keep Kids Safe

- Farms have lots of dangerous chemicals that are used for cleaning and for getting rid of pests
- Dangerous chemicals should all be kept in containers with lids and labels on them
- The labels on chemical containers have a pictogram (pictures) which tells you what could go wrong

Draw a line and match the pictograms below to their meaning



**Oxidiser**

(can make fires get worse)

**Very Very Poisonous**

(could be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or touched)

**Corrosive**

(will badly burn skin)

**Very Poisonous**

(health hazard especially if breathed in)

**Environmental Hazard**

(can harm living things in water and on land)

**Gas Cylinder**

**Flammable**

(can catch fire very easily)

**Explosive**

(will go 'boom' like a gunshot)

**Toxic!**

(harmful if touched, breathed or swallowed)
