Keep Kids Safe

- start a farm safety conversation with your children
- Use this worksheet to make your children aware of farm hazards
- Farms have lots of dangerous chemicals that are used for cleaning and for getting rid of
- > Dangerous chemicals should all be kept in containers with lids and labels on them
- > The labels on chemical containers have a pictogram (pictures) which tells you what could go wrong

(can make fires get worse)



Very Very Poisonous

(could be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or touched)



Corrosive

(will badly burn skin)



Very Poisonous

(health hazard especially if breathed in)



Environmental Hazard

(can harm living things in water and on land)



Gas Cylinder



(can catch fire very easily)



Explosive

(will go 'boom' like a gunshot)



Toxic!

(harmful if touched, breathed or swallowed)
