What is our Speed Limit on farm?

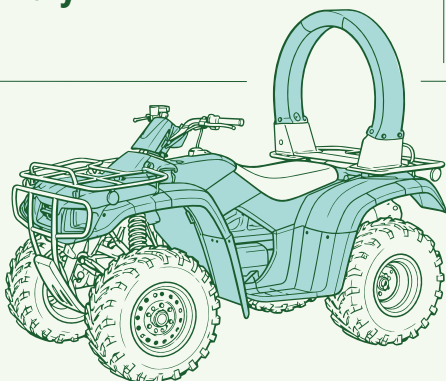
Does it change:

If you're speeding and turning, that's worse!

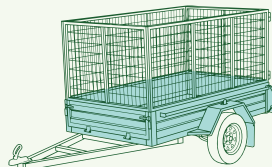
TEAM QUESTION
