4. Pause to reflect.

The magic often happens when you sit with a question a moment longer.

5. Test your pitch live.

Try it in a real networking room – or record yourself and listen back.

6. Revisit before events.

Slight tweaks in tone or ask can supercharge results for specific rooms.

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
