

Another 101 Outreach Ideas

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You asked for more ways to serve your city—here they are. Another 101 ideas to help your church love people the way Jesus does. You don't need a big budget or a big team. You just need a willing heart and a place to start.

Community Engagement & Support

1. Host a free garage sale: provide free items to those in need.
2. Organize a teacher's classroom: help set up classrooms before the school year.
3. Provide dignity kits: offer hygiene products for young girls in schools.
4. Bus stop cleanups: keep bus stops clean and inviting.
5. Paint fire hydrants: work with local fire departments.
6. Cold drinks for construction workers: provide water on hot days.
7. Return carts for grocery shoppers: help customers with their carts.
8. Flowers for social workers: show appreciation for their hard work.
9. Respite care for foster families: offer babysitting for foster parents.
10. Refurbish park benches: restore seating in parks.

11. Create a Little Free Library: install book-sharing stations.
12. Power-wash sidewalks and storefronts for local small businesses.
13. Host a street cleanup day: encourage teams to beautify streets.
14. Stock a neighborhood blessing box with pantry staples.
15. Organize a community picnic: foster connections among neighbors.

Support for Vulnerable Populations

16. Teach tech skills to seniors: help them navigate smartphones and computers.
17. Disability-friendly events: plan inclusive activities.
18. Homeless care packages: provide hygiene kits, snacks, and resource guides.
19. Host a grief support luncheon for those who've lost loved ones.
20. Home repair for the elderly: fix minor home issues for seniors.

- 21. Assemble sleeping bags for the homeless: distribute in cold months.
- 22. Volunteer at a women's shelter: offer support and companionship.
- 23. Sponsor a local family: provide groceries and essential items.
- 24. Provide free transportation: help seniors get to medical appointments.
- 25. Support single parents: offer child care and resources.

Educational Initiatives

- 26. After-school tutoring: support students struggling in school.
- 27. Financial literacy workshops: teach budgeting and saving skills.
- 28. Offer free ESL conversation classes for new English speakers.
- 29. Adult literacy classes: help adults learn to read and write.
- 30. STEM exploration days: inspire kids with science and technology.
- 31. Homework help nights: provide study assistance.
- 32. Trade skills training: offer basic plumbing, carpentry, and mechanical skills.
- 33. Scholarship fundraising: raise money for underprivileged students.

Environmental Stewardship

- 92. Wrap Christmas presents for free at a local mall.
- 93. Christmas caroling & gift baskets: sing and spread holiday cheer.
- 94. Holiday movie nights: host community Christmas movie screenings.
