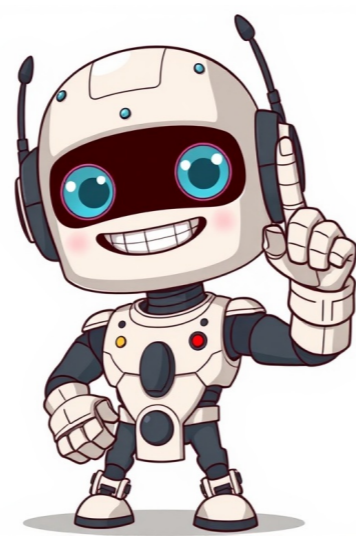

Looking forward to playing the '30-Seconds' game with everyone tomorrow and trying to guess as many subject words as possible from these 225 printable PDF cards. Each card has five subjects that need to be described within a short time frame of 30 seconds, covering topics like people, movies, cities, brands, etc. You can play this game in teams or pairs.\*To start playing the '30-Seconds' game\*In team mode, one player draws a card and begins reading out the five subject words without repeating any of them. The timer starts counting down from 30 seconds, and the player's teammates have to guess as many words as possible based on their description. The order of the subject words does not matter, and the players cannot use any of the words mentioned on the card. When time is up, the team earns a point for every correctly guessed word. Then it's the next team's turn in playing this fun game. In pair mode, you can either play to guess as many points as possible or just enjoy the game without any scoring. The players take turns guessing and describing the subject words, with each pair receiving the same number of cards. The pair with the most points at the end wins. You can also use this game for different periods of time and in various settings, like a long class where one student draws a card while others guess. The subjects might have an European bias, so you can edit the cards to suit your needs. Due to the level of difficulty required, we recommend this game for players aged 14 and above. I used these cards as labels on bigger cardboard cards and had fun playing them. If there is enough demand, I will consider creating expansion packs.
