The station's history dates back to 1945 when it was first awarded a concession for operation at 250 watts on 1370 kHz. Initially, XETQ-AM was one of three radio stations in Orizaba, following government-owned XEFD and privately owned XEPP. By the 1960s, it transformed into a clear-channel station on 850 kHz, receiving authorization for 100 kW day/50 kW night. However, by the 1990s, the high power level was reduced to a 10 kW day/1 kW night pattern. In 2013, XETQ-AM ceased operations and was converted to an FM radio station as XHTQ-FM on 101.3 MHz. The facility details for Facility ID 101573 (XETQ) can be found in the FCC Licensing and Management System. This article is a stub regarding a radio station in Veracruz, and contributions are welcome to expand its content. The current technical specifications of XHTQ-FM include an ERP of 3 kW, HAAT of 53.75 m, and transmitter coordinates at 18°52′40.05″N 97°07′15.75″W﻿ / ﻿18.8777917°N 97.1210417°W﻿ / 18.8777917; -97.1210417. The station can be visited online through its official website, www.rogsa.mx. XHTQ-FM's sister stations include XHOV-FM, and the concession for XETQ was initially awarded to Francisco Campos H. in 1945, specifying operation at 250 watts on 1370 kHz. This radio station is part of a larger broadcasting network that offers various music genres and formats. The Romántica 101.3 branding is synonymous with XHTQ-FM's programming schedule, catering to listeners' preferences for romantic music. The broadcast area primarily covers Orizaba and Ixhuatlancillo in Veracruz, Mexico. The station's online presence can be accessed through the provided website link.
