Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA)

CRRSAA (HEERF II) provides funding to institutions for emergency Financial Aid Grants to students whose lives have been disrupted by the Coronavirus pandemic. Below is Nouvelle Institute Initial report.

With regard to the CRRSAA Act Section (CFDA 84.425E) or Proprietary Institution Grant Funds for Students (CFDA 84.4525Q) Nouvelle Institute acknowledges and assures that:

- 1. A signed Certification and Agreements was returned to the Department of Education on March 31, 2021 with the intention of using 50% of the funds received to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 2. The total amount of funds that Nouvelle Institute received for the benefit of students is \$394,860.
- 3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Cares Act as the date of submission of March 31, 2021 is \$0.
- 4. As of March 31, 2021 no students have received funding.
- 5. Nouvelle Institute determined that all Title IV students that were active thru March 31, 2021 and fill out the application and acceptance forms according to Emergency Grants for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to Coronavirus (including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as tuition, food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care) will receive an equal amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section (CFDA 84.425E) of the CRRSAA Act into one installments and taking in consideration the requirements for eligibility.
- 6. The students were notify through Financial Aid Office with instructions of who will be eligible for Emergency Aid and requirements. Also to the date that the distribution of the checks will begin.
