



France: L'Albadu Farm: Booking Conditions

As a booking facilitator, saddletravel.com does not create or organise the travel packages offered. Instead, we connect clients with third-party operators who independently arrange all aspects of the travel arrangements, including accommodation, horseback riding activities, and transportation. Our role is solely to facilitate the reservation process.

Payment and Cancellation Conditions

Vacations are confirmed with a non-refundable deposit of 20%. The full balance must be paid 56 days before the departure date. If you cancel your reservation less than 56 days prior to the start of your stay, we reserve the right to charge the full amount, minus the following refunds:

- 42 days or more before the date: 50%
- 30 days or more before the date: 30%
- Less than 30 days: no refund

Insurance

All clients are required to take out suitable travel insurance covering horseback riding and trip cancellation. Proof of insurance details may be requested during the booking process.

General Booking Conditions of L'Albadu Farm

Article 1 – Awareness of risks

I acknowledge that I have been informed that horseback riding, especially outdoor riding, involves inherent risks related to:

- the behavior of the animal,
- terrain and weather conditions,
- travel in natural environments or on public roads.

I agree to participate fully aware of these risks and undertake to follow safety instructions provided by the organizer and guides.

Article 2 – Liability

I hereby release the organizer, its representatives, and guides from any civil or criminal liability in case of physical, material, or immaterial damage during the stay, except in cases of gross negligence or proven misconduct on their part.

Article 3 – Insurance

I certify that I have valid third-party liability insurance covering my participation in equestrian activities.

I am aware that I am responsible for purchasing personal accident insurance if I wish to be personally covered in case of bodily injury.

Article 4 – Health status

I declare that I am medically fit to participate in horseback riding and have no known contraindications.

I commit to informing the organizer of any specific health issues, ongoing treatments, or allergies.

Article 5 – Personal commitment

I agree to:

- follow safety and hygiene rules,
- wear recommended protective equipment (notably a certified helmet),
- adopt responsible behavior towards the horses, other riders, and the environment.

Article 6 – Equipment entrusted

I acknowledge that equipment (horse, harness, grooming tools, loaned equipment, etc.) may be entrusted to me for the duration of the stay.

I undertake to:

- use the equipment carefully and respectfully,
- immediately report any loss, anomaly, or damage observed,
- return the equipment in the condition in which it was entrusted to me, except for normal wear and tear related to the activity.
