



Estonia: Tihuse Farm - Booking Conditions

As a booking facilitator, saddletravel.com does not create or organise the travel packages on offer. Instead, we connect customers with third-party operators who independently organise all aspects of the travel packages, including accommodations, horse riding activities, and transport. Our role is limited to facilitating the booking only.

Payment & Cancellation Terms

Holidays are confirmed with a 20% non-refundable deposit. The full balance is due 56 days before the start date. If you cancel your booking less than 56 days before the start date of your trail we are entitled to receive full payment, less refunds as follows: 42 days or more before booking date - 50%, 30 days or more - 30% less than 30 days - nil

Insurance

All customers are required to take out appropriate travel insurance that covers horse riding and holiday cancellation. Proof of insurance details will be required during the booking process.

Tihuse Farm Terms & Conditions

1. Riding at your own risk

Horseback riding is entirely at your own risk. Tihuse Horse Tourism Farm is not liable for any accidents or injuries. We strongly recommend valid accident insurance.

2. Helmet use

For your safety, wearing a riding helmet is mandatory. If you do not have your own helmet, you can borrow one from us.

3. Appropriate clothing and footwear

Wear comfortable, wind- and waterproof clothing, and non-slip gloves. Long pants are mandatory; we recommend non-slippery sweatpants or jeans without inner seams. Shoes should be closed, sporty, and with a small heel (1–2 cm). Open-heeled shoes and flip-flops are not allowed.

4. Leading the horse

Always hold the reins or lead rope when leading a horse, and do not wrap them around your hand or body. Lead the horse from its left side, keeping the horse on your right, beside you—not behind you.

5. Behavior near horses

Avoid sudden movements and loud noises near horses, as these may frighten them. Do not stand directly behind a horse or approach it unexpectedly.

6. During the ride

Keep a safe distance between horses to avoid unexpected reactions. Always follow the guide's instructions and do not leave the group or the line without permission. We do not ride side by side!

7. Unpredictable behavior of horses

Remember that horses are living beings and their behavior can be unpredictable. Be prepared for sudden movements and stay calm.

8. Pace and duration of the ride

The ride's pace and duration will be set according to the least experienced rider in the group. If you have any special requests or limitations, please inform Tihuse Farm when making your booking.

9. Health condition

If you have any health issues that could affect your ability to ride, please inform Tihuse Farm when booking your ride.

10. Respect for nature and property

Protect nature and follow local rules. Do not litter and stay on designated paths.
