Our role is limited to facilitating the booking only.

Payment & Cancellation Terms

Holidays are confirmed with a 20% non-refundable deposit. The full balance is due 56 days before the start date. If you cancel your booking less than 56 days before the start date of your trail we are entitled to receive full payment, less refunds as follows: 42 days or more before booking date - 50%, 30 days or more - 30% less than 30 days - nil

Insurance

All customers are required to take out appropriate travel insurance that covers horse riding and holiday cancellation. Proof of insurance details will be required during the booking process.

1. Cancellations

- We reserve the right to cancel a ride due to weather, safety, or unforeseen events. A full refund or alternative dates will be offered.

2. Insurance

- All riders must have valid travel and personal accident insurance that covers horse riding activities.
 - We are not responsible for loss, injury, or damage to personal belongings.
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3. Rider Requirements

- Riders must be physically fit and able to control a horse at walk and trot (canter for advanced rides).
 - Minimum age: [18years old] (unless otherwise agreed).
 - Helmets are mandatory for all riders. Riders may bring their own or request one from us.
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4. Assumption of Risk & Liability

- Horse riding is an adventure activity that carries inherent risks. All riders participate at their own risk.
 - We do our best to ensure safety, but by joining our rides, you accept these risks and agree to follow guide instructions at all times.
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5. Changes to the Itinerary

- We reserve the right to modify routes or programs due to weather, local conditions, or safety concerns.
 - If changes are necessary, we will inform you as early as possible.
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6. Conduct

- Riders are expected to treat horses, guides, and fellow participants with respect.
- Dangerous, disrespectful, or intoxicated behavior may lead to removal from the ride without refund.
