

## Homework 01: Curated Collection

**Goal:** Master selecting images for a project. Collect **8-10** images that present a variety of photo shoots and tell a visual story of the **one-day experience** at the "dream place" you indicated in your intro slide. Use both direct and symbolic visuals. If the symbolic meaning is not obvious, consider adding a brief explanation. Refer to the examples provided for layout organization. Suggested dimensions for each layout: height - 800px or 8.5"; width - as needed. "Reduce file size" before uploading.

**Software:** Photoshop for image adjustments and editing. Figma or any other software of your choice for organizing.

**Page 1** - submission checklist

**Page 2** - 8-10 images collection with time labels and experience description ("time sequence")

**Page 3** - reuse the same layout with the images reorganized to show shots progression ("shots sequence"), credits, and keywords. Digital submission only (Canvas).
