### 5. Additional information about ZAO Mizuho Corporate Bank (Moscow)

The merger of Mizuho Corporate Bank, Ltd. and Mizuho Bank, Ltd. does not affect the legal status of ZAO Mizuho Corporate Bank (Moscow), since it is an independent legal entity, which is registered and operates in the Russian Federation. There is no change to the Bank's shareholders, but our key shareholder, Mizuho Corporate Bank. Ltd., will change its name to Mizuho Bank, Ltd. However, it will remain the same legal entity.

We would also like to inform you that we are going to change our name from ZAO Mizuho Corporate Bank (Moscow) to ZAO Mizuho Bank (Moscow). Since the name change and the relevant changes in the Charter shall be registered in the Unified State Register of Legal Entities, we will additionally notify you of the legal change of the name.

There is no change to other details of the Bank, including settlement details, SWIFT and BIC codes.
