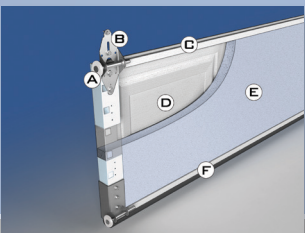
## PANEL COLORS & DESIGNS
