

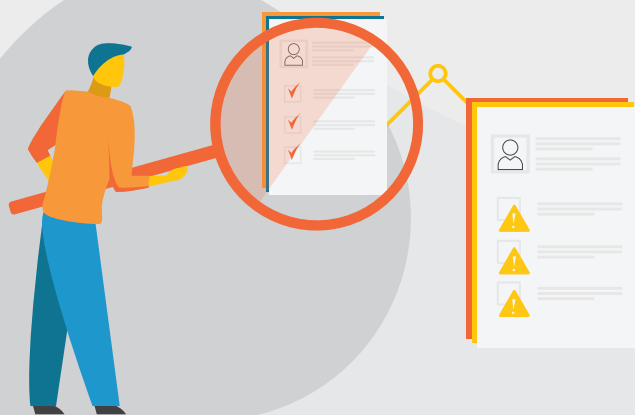

Assess your current expertise to address Interoperability and FHIR APIs.

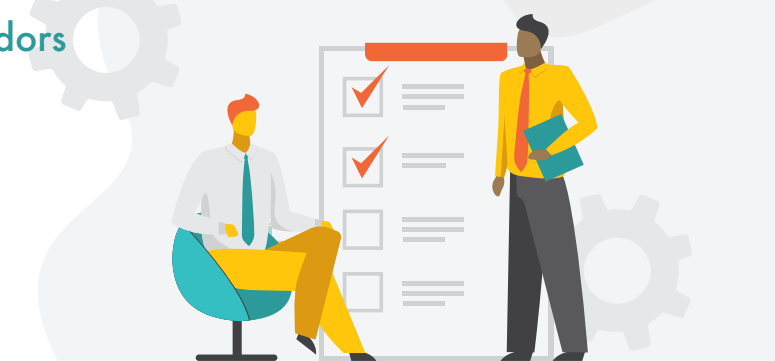
Utilize in-house or contract expertise to ensure:

- ▶ Support for HL7 FHIR R4
- ▶ Ability to support United States Core Data for Interoperability (USCDI)
 - ▶ 16 data classes, 52 data elements

Engage experts including partners and vendors to assist with plan and implementation.

- ▶ Consumerism Initiatives
- ▶ Value-based Care Programs
- ▶ Quality and Risk



Perform complete data assessment across business units.

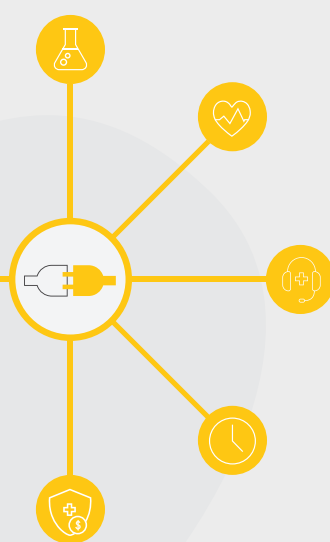
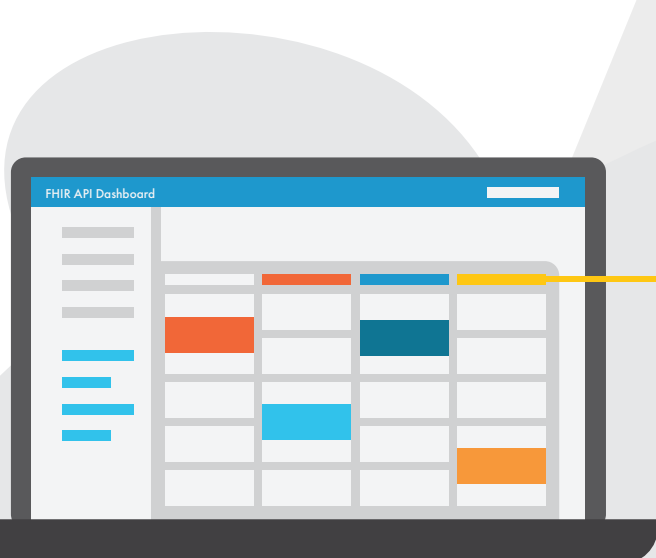
Things to consider:

- ▶ Current level of patient access to data
- ▶ Ability to provide risk info to patients
- ▶ Current timeline for data access

Build and test APIs.

3 APIs required:

- ▶ Patient Access
- ▶ Provider Directory
- ▶ Payer-to-Payer Data Exchange



Maintain APIs and support third-party app developers.

1500+ application developers are currently building tools to connect to the Blue Button 2.0 API – prepare to support a similar level of participation.
