RULES AND FORMAT

1. USGA rules shall govern play, except as modified by local rules on back of scorecards.
2. Carts: 90 rule in effect, except where designated by course signage.
3. Tees: Ladies play from silver tees
Men play from gold tees
4. Golfers will play a four-person scramble. Through the green, the ball may be marked, lifted, cleaned and placed within one club length of the position chosen no nearer the hole, without changing the conditions of play (i.e. if the ball is in the rough it must stay in the rough).
5. Team Captain is responsible for returning scorecards to scoreboard immediately following the completion of play.
6. A mixed team is classified as having members of both genders.
7. In order to speed up play, you may tap in close putts even though the rest of your team has not completed the putting cycle. Use the lower score.
8. Please pick up once you have a bogey on the hole. Please keep up with the group in front of you.
9. Hole #5 will be played as a par 3.



11. FAVOR THE LEFT CENTER FROM THE TEE. THE APPROACH HAS TO BE VERY ACCURATE OVER THE LAKE AND BUNKERS.

10. EXACT PIN PLACEMENT IS HARD TO SEE BECAUSE OF THE UPHILL APPROACH. SHOT, DOUBLE CHECK THE DISTANCE BEFORE YOU SWING.

12. A TIGHT DRIVING HOLE. WATCH THE WATER ON RIGHT AND THE OB ON THE LEFT.

13. Hole in One Contest Closest to the Pin

13. A GOOD PAR 3 REQUIRING A LONG IRON INTO A PREVAILING WIND TO HIT THE WELL-BUNKERED GREEN.

16. Closest to the Pin

15. A TRICKY 5 PAR CONSISTING OF A SHARP DOGLEG TO THE LEFT WITH A WATER HAZARD IN FRONT OF THE WELL-BUNKERED STEEP FIGURE EIGHT GREEN.

18. THE CHALLENGE OF A LARGE TREE PROTECTING THE APPROACH TO THE GREEN IS AMPLIFIED BY A NARROW FAIRWAY AND THE LAKE TO THE LEFT.

14. A VERY DEMANDING DRIVING HOLE. CAREFUL PLACEMENT IS NECESSARY DUE TO THE 5 BUNKERS IN THE LANDING AREA.

2. Closest to the Pin

2. THIS GREEN SLOPES FROM BACK TO FRONT WITH A HUMP IN THE MIDDLE. SO WATCH THE BREAK AND PUTTING SPEED. THIS CAN BE AN EASY 3-PUTT.

17. KEEP RIGHT OF THE TEE. ON THIS TOUGH PAR 4, GREEN IS WELL-BUNKERED. PLAY IS TO THE MIDDLE OF THE GREEN.

1. BECAUSE OUR OPENING HOLE IS PLAYED UP-HILL, TRY GOING ONE CLUB LONGER ON YOUR THIRD SHOT. THE TARGET IS A VERY LARGE GREEN.

9. A WELL-HIT DRIVE INTO THE MIDDLE OF THE FAIRWAY LEAVES A SHORT IRON APPROACH SHOT TO THE LARGE HOGBACK GREEN.

8. Birdie Challenge with Dan Boever

8. THE BEST SPOT TO AIM FOR IS JUST TO THE RIGHT OF THE TREE OVERHANGING THE GREEN.

7. TIGHT DRIVING HOLE. PLAY TO THE RIGHT TO COMPENSATE FOR FAIRWAY SLOPE TO THE LEFT.

6. YOUR APPROACH SHOT IS GOING TO REQUIRE CARRY. THE SOFT FAIRWAY IN FRONT OF THE GREEN REDUCES THE CHANCES OF A GOOD ROLL.

5. THIS HOLE DOGLEGS TO THE LEFT BUT WATCH THE LEFT SIDE SLOPE. A TEE SHOT JUST SHORT OF THE RIGHT SIDE BUNKERS LEAVES AN EASY APPROACH.

16. A SUPER 3 PAR. THIS HOLE PLAYS 165 YARDS LONGER DUE TO THE PREVAILING WIND AND IS CAPPED OFF BY AN UNDULATING GREEN.

4. OUR BEST 4 PAR. THE SECOND SHOT REQUIRES A WOOD OR LONG IRON TO THE WELL-BUNKERED GREEN.

3. A WELL PLACED TEE SHOT TO THE RIGHT SIDE CAN SET UP A SHORT IRON APPROACH FOR A ROUTINE PAR.

6. Most Accurate Drive
