#### Primary Pain Endpoints & Patient Centricity

**Patient compliance is key** to ensuring high-quality data. To minimize burden, we implement **electronic Clinical Outcome Assessments (eCOA)** – including ePROs and eDiaries – accessible via apps, tablets, smartphones, or PCs. This approach enhances patient experience, boosts compliance, and strengthens data integrity.

For trial participants unable to self-report – such as young children – observers (e.g., parents, caregivers) provide **Observer-Reported Outcomes (ObsRO)** based on observable signs like wincing, crying, or squirming. **Clinician-Reported Outcomes (ClinRO)** are similarly limited to observable data.
