The patented structural system withstands winds in excess of 186 km/h. For those used to panoramic courts, this is the next level: more elegant, more impressive and safer to play on with wire mesh flush to the glass and running continuously between frames.

Padel Plus is the only distributor to offer The Infinity Court with lighting from ProSportLED – the market leading spec which minimizes glare for players and reduces light spill to virtually zero. It's lean to operate with significant cost savings over five years.

The Infinity Court is available with all our usual customisation and accessories, and is warranted for an incredible 15 years inland (10 years in coastal locations).

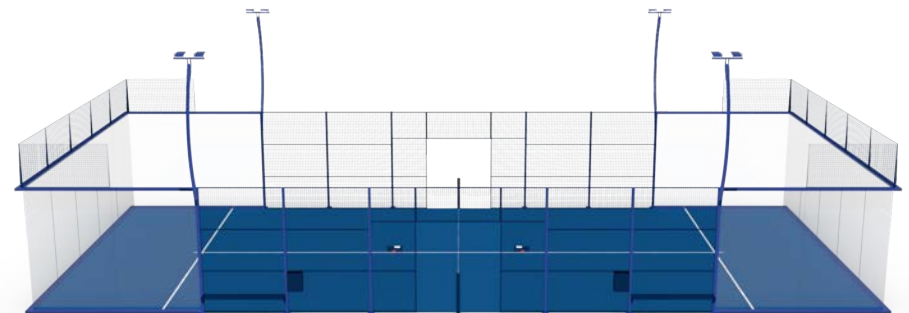
Our premium court combines a minimalist design with maximum performance for both players and spectators. There are no pillars in the corners meaning great visibility into and out of the court.

The carbon steel (S235) hot galvanized (Z275) structure ensures optimum stability, strength and longevity.

Each component from the steel frame, glass, artificial turf, lighting and court-side accessories has been developed to be a proud addition to the most demanding of schools, clubs or homes.

Our Vision / Club Court is developed to be the ideal solution for club environments and represents a helpful saving per court against our premium Panoramic version. The additional steel along the rear wall provides increased strength and stability in high-use environments.

3m high steel pilasters ensure optimum stability and strength.

Each component from the steel frame, glass, artificial turf, lighting and court-side accessories has been developed to be a proud addition to the most demanding of clubs.

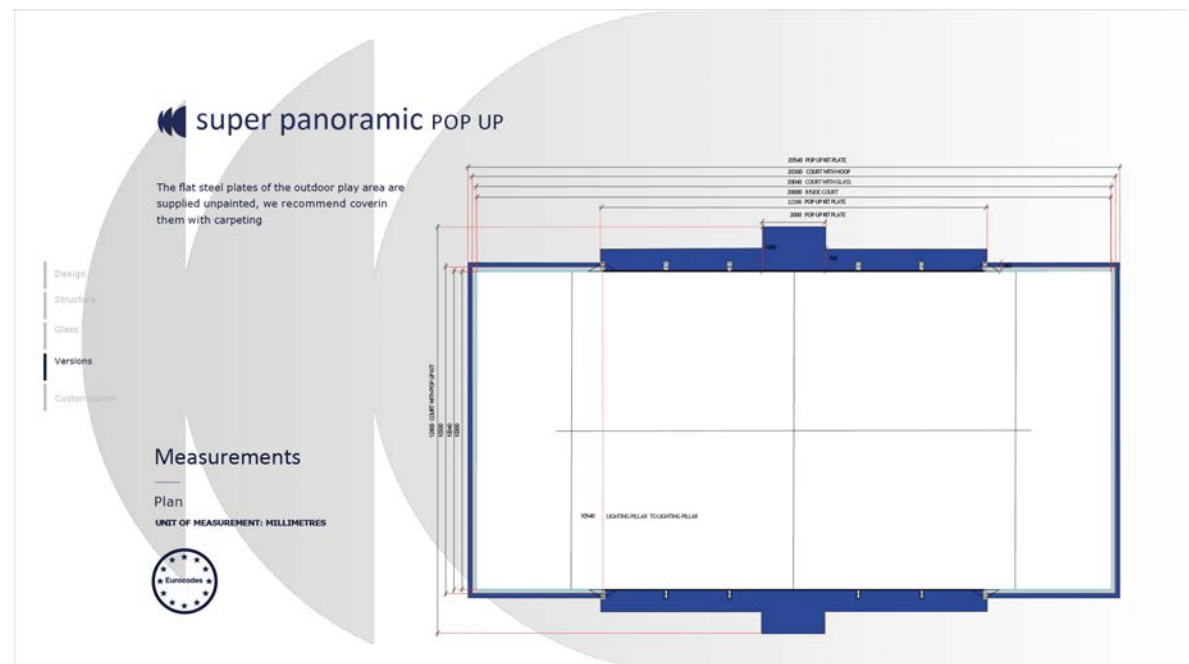
Pop-up Versions

Temporary installations without sacrificing stability

All our courts are available as **pop-up versions** – that is similar court frames that can be installed on suitable surfaces **without being tied to conventional ring beam foundations.**

- + Ideal for temporary installations (eg exhibitions, events, tournaments)
- + Ideal for sites where planning legislation might demand short term or reversible use of a site
- + Ideal for sites where the ground under the court cannot be damaged
- + Ideal for clubs wanting to introduce padel to gauge interest without making an investment in ground works that may not be needed long-term
- + Courts can be **easily moved and reinstalled elsewhere** either on a temporary or permanent basis
- + Pop-up courts are typically £5,500 more than the conventional version of the same model (on account of the additional design & materials that provide the stability in lieu of permanent foundations) but given the savings on groundworks (typically £35-40k per court) they represent **amazing value for money**

Below | The key difference is the use of steel plates (see blue area in the diagram) that extend along the length of the court, centred around the court openings. These increase the surface area of the court frame in contact with the ground. Combined with the significant weight of the courts, these plates ensure stability despite not being tied to concrete foundations. Note it is also possible to bolt pop-up courts to the surface (in situations where a suitable base exists).



LED Lighting by ProSportLED

Padel Plus partners ProSportLED, pioneers of both indoor and outdoor racket sport lighting, to bring industry-leading LED expertise to our courts. ProSportLED's knowledge stems from understanding the needs of athletes, the capabilities of LED manufacturers and the qualities operators look for when fitting out their facilities. The result is an optimal playing experience and the benefit of energy savings and great customer feedback for operators.

Outdoor and Outdoor Covered Space Lighting

Alongside noise, light pollution can be a significant problem in terms of planning considerations. If your site uses a symmetrical light fixture (direct) it is likely to be in a neighbour's line of vision. Diffusing the light will only soften its appearance whilst leaving the light very much in view.

The solution is an asymmetrical light fixture. The Maha product line from ProSportLED will illuminate the court precisely with all light fixtures installed parallel (0°) to the playing surface. Our light cut-off technology provides exact control with virtually zero light pollution (see image).

Other benefits include:

- + 20KV Surge protection from electrical storms
- + Optimal efficiency with a class-leading 145 lumens per watt, combined with the IPC WiFi controller can maximize energy savings by connecting up to 200 fixtures to 1 controller
- + The LED Converter technology from KMW excels when filming match play or tuition. The non-flicker converter allows for slow-motion filming at 1,500 frames per second compatible with broadcast 4k and 8k cameras

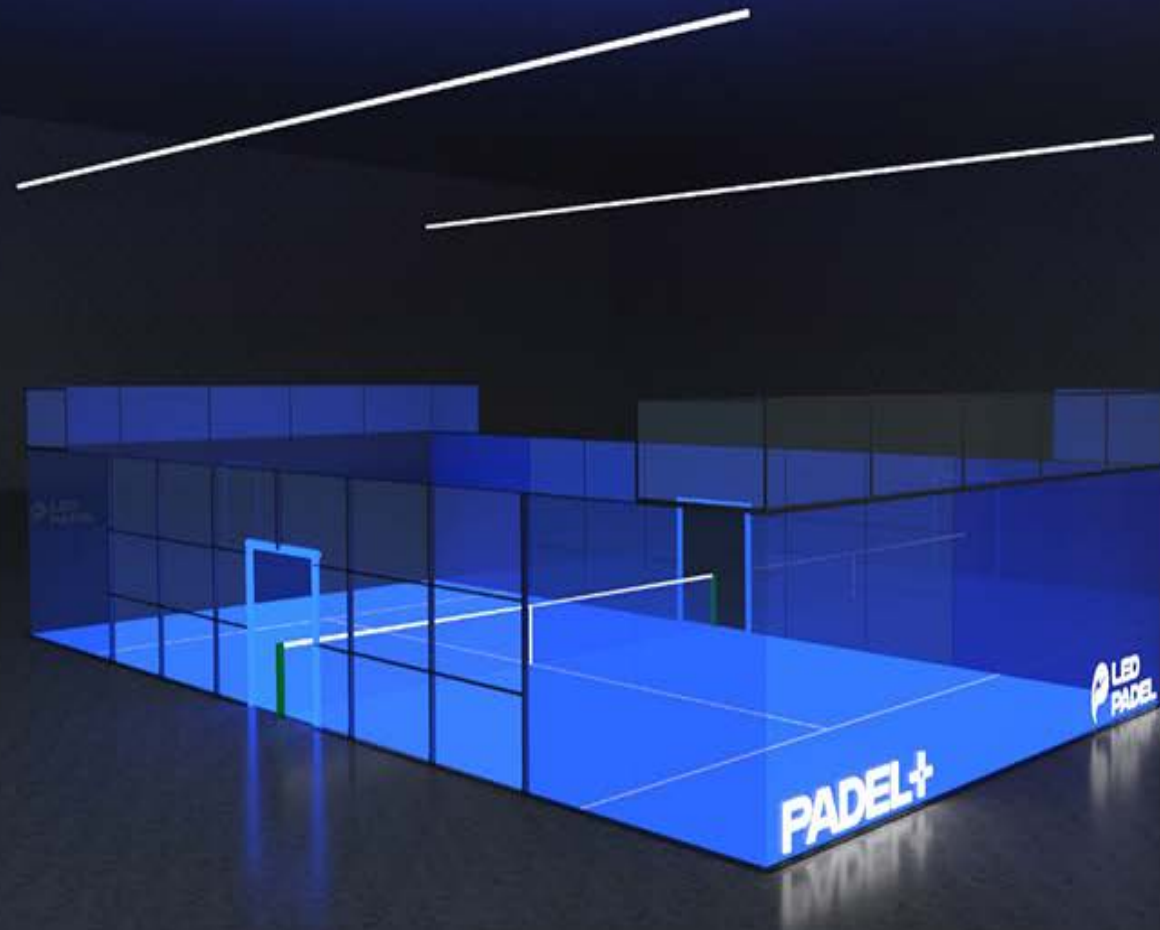
We are excited to launch a linear lighting solution that will transform your padel experience – both for players and owner/operators.

Not just a game changer but a game winner. Our linear lighting fixtures provide flicker-free continuous lighting above the side walls of the court that ensure uniform lux levels across all areas of the playing surface, minimal shadows and almost zero glare. Crucially there are no lights above the back walls as we firmly believe players should not look directly into a lighting source. In other words the lighting runs parallel to the direction of play.

This system is designed specifically for padel with the highest quality components. Operating costs are extremely low meaning significant savings over 5 and 10 year periods. The fixtures are elegant in appearance and yet tough and durable.

Our 4-in-1 transformational system provides:

- + the best court lighting
- + courtesy lighting for the surrounding spaces
- + maintenance lighting
- + emergency lighting
- + a 10 year warranty covering 100,000 hours of operation with zero light depreciation

Padel Plus Linear Lighting

Case Study for an 8 Court Club

Overview

This analysis compares three LED lighting solutions for achieving the required 500 lux average illuminance at an 8-metre mounting height, in line with EN 12193 standards and LTA guidelines for competitive and club-level padel play.

- + **Baseline Option:** Conventional LED floodlight system (typical industry standard). Provides adequate illumination but with poorer playability due to higher risk of glare, shadows, and less consistent uniformity.
- + **Recommended Primary Option:** Premium Linear LED System. Padel+ 800 variant (preferred for superior playability).
- + **Recommended Secondary Option:** Premium Linear LED System. Padel+ 1200 variant (strong alternative with excellent efficiency).

The premium Linear Systems deliver significantly superior playability compared to the baseline, with enhanced uniformity, reduced glare, elimination of shadows/hot spots, and better overall visual comfort for players (critical in padel due to frequent high balls, lobs and smashes).

The Padel+ 800 is positioned as the top choice for playability, while the Padel+ 1200 offers a compelling secondary option with even greater energy efficiency.

Annual Operating Costs (at £0.24/kWh *)

Assumptions: 3,600 operating hours per court per year (10 hours/day × 360 days/year)

Per Court

- + Baseline (Conventional LED lights) ~3,360 W total: £2,903 per year
- + Premium Linear System: Padel+ 800 ~1,360 W total: £1,175 per year
- + Premium Linear System: Padel+ 1200 ~1,100 W total: £950 per year

* 24p is standard, but sites may qualify for 21p-23p based on the building size.

Total for 8 Courts

- + Baseline: £23,224 per year
- + Padel+ 800: £9,400 per year
- + Padel+ 1200: £7,600 per year

Annual Energy Savings

- + With Padel+ 800: £13,824 (≈60% reduction, up to ~70% with 10% dimming)
- + With Padel+ 1200: £15,624 (≈67–77% reduction, incl potential 10% dimming)

Cumulative Energy Savings (Energy Costs Only)

+ 5 Yr Savings

- + With Padel+ 800: £69,120
- + With Padel+ 1200: £78,120

+ 10 Yr Savings

- + With Padel+ 800: £138,240
- + With Padel+ 1200: £156,240

Note: These figures represent electricity costs only. Additional substantial savings will accrue from:

- + Reduced maintenance and replacement costs (Linear Systems rated for 100,000 operating hours)
- + Minimal downtime and associated revenue impact

Key Advantages of the Premium Linear Systems

- + **Superior playability & player experience** — Excellent uniformity ($E_{min}/E_{avg} = 0.7-0.8$), low Unified Glare Rating, no shadows or hot spots → enhanced visibility for tracking the ball, greater comfort during play (especially on high shots), increased court utilisation, player satisfaction, and suitability for tournaments. The Padel+ 800 is prioritised for best overall playability.
- + **Substantial long-term cost reduction** — Annual savings of £19,000 – £21,000+ across the site; typical payback period on the incremental capital investment: 2–5 years.
- + **Exceptional reliability & durability** — 100,000-hour LED lifespan significantly reduces fixture replacements and maintenance compared to conventional floodlights.
- + **Environmental & reputational benefits** — Lower energy consumption and carbon footprint support sustainability objectives and may assist with UK planning and environmental considerations.

Considerations

- + **Higher initial capital investment** — The Linear Systems utilise premium fixtures and specialised optics, resulting in a higher upfront cost than conventional floodlights.
- + The Padel+ 800 provides marginally higher energy use than the 1200, but is recommended as the primary choice for optimised playability.

Recommendation

For a facility of this scale, the Premium Linear LED System (Padel+ 800 as the primary, with Padel+ 1200 as the strong secondary) is the optimal solution. It prioritises best-in-class playability and player experience while delivering substantial energy and operational cost savings, excellent return on investment, and long-term reliability.



Above | The Padel+ 1200 Linear System, shown as a 60m installation providing 360° coverage. Our recommendation is to light along the sides of the court only (Padel+ 800), but we can install above all walls for customers wanting the complete halo.

View 1 | Our steel and polycarbonate canopies provide a light, bright and airy playing environment, the closest possible experience to playing outdoors, but with the benefit of certainty of play, whatever the weather conditions.



View 2 | We have a range of products to seal the bottom 3m to ground level including extending the polycarbonate sidings, motorised awnings, or sliding glass doors. Along with keeping out wind and driving rain, they increase security. The final spec needs to respond carefully to the requirements of the site.

Positioning The Product

Padel Plus Pavilions...

We deliberately position our product as an enduring and high quality solution, aimed at clubs or operators with vision beyond short-term commercial gain. These are facilities that create a first class legacy. There are other providers of steel and polycarbonate canopies in the UK offering 'premium products' but it is important to understand the differences which might lead to a price discrepancy. Padel Plus Pavilions:

- + Are designed to meet EN 1993 Eurocode 3 – this is concerned with requirements for resistance, serviceability, durability and fire resistance of steel structures. Our pavilions are permanent structures designed for life.
- + Use hot dip galvanized steel to prevent corrosion over lifespan.
- + Use the best quality of polycarbonate on the market. We specify 30mm Danpalon® which is more costly than other polycarbonate sheets. But it provides exceptional quality of light, a rich non-industrial visual appeal and delivers thermal insulation and UV protection. By filtering the amount of light depending on the different daytime hours, Danpalon® contributes to optimal efficiency and significant savings in energy costs.
- + Manufactured and installed by Cubinor, a specialist in sports canopies who has completed projects across Europe including prestigious structures for Ciudad de la Raqueta in Madrid with 11,000m² of canopy covered courts. Padel Plus is their exclusive UK partner.
- + Designed to provide optimum playing conditions: the closest experience to playing outdoors but with the benefit of certainty of play whatever the weather conditions.
- + It is sustainable design for long-term and economic operation.



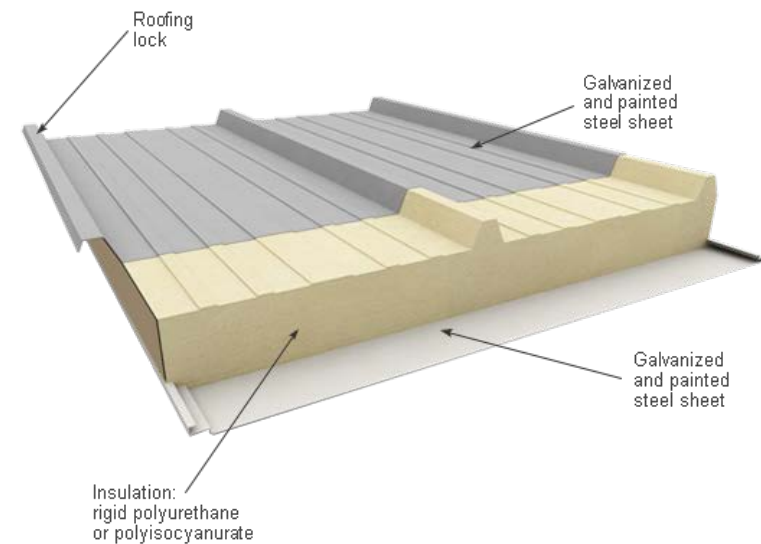
Canopy Options

Material variations to suit different budgets

Our Premium Canopy (Option 1) is made entirely of 30mm thick cellular polycarbonate mounted on aluminum profiles anchored directly to the purlin structure. Joint covers secure the panels without the need for perforation. This design allows the polycarbonate to cope with thermal expansion without any risk of cracking. The facades are covered in matching 30mm thick cellular polycarbonate. The construction ensures the entire structure is well insulated, weather resistant and filters out all UV rays. These canopies provide a wonderful light, bright and airy playing environment and means artificial light is only needed during extremely dark conditions or at night time (unlike PVC canopies which require artificial lighting at all times).



Our Standard+ Canopy (Option 2): the roof enclosure is constructed with lacquered and galvanized steel & foam core sandwich panels, featuring a simple gable design. This choice of materials provides durability and insulation at a lower price. The facades are closed from a height of 3m upwards with 30mm thick cellular polycarbonate sheets joined using the same system as the roof. This provides an aesthetically pleasing appearance and also ensures optimal insulation and weather resistance. It is the best choice when roof-top solar panels are required.



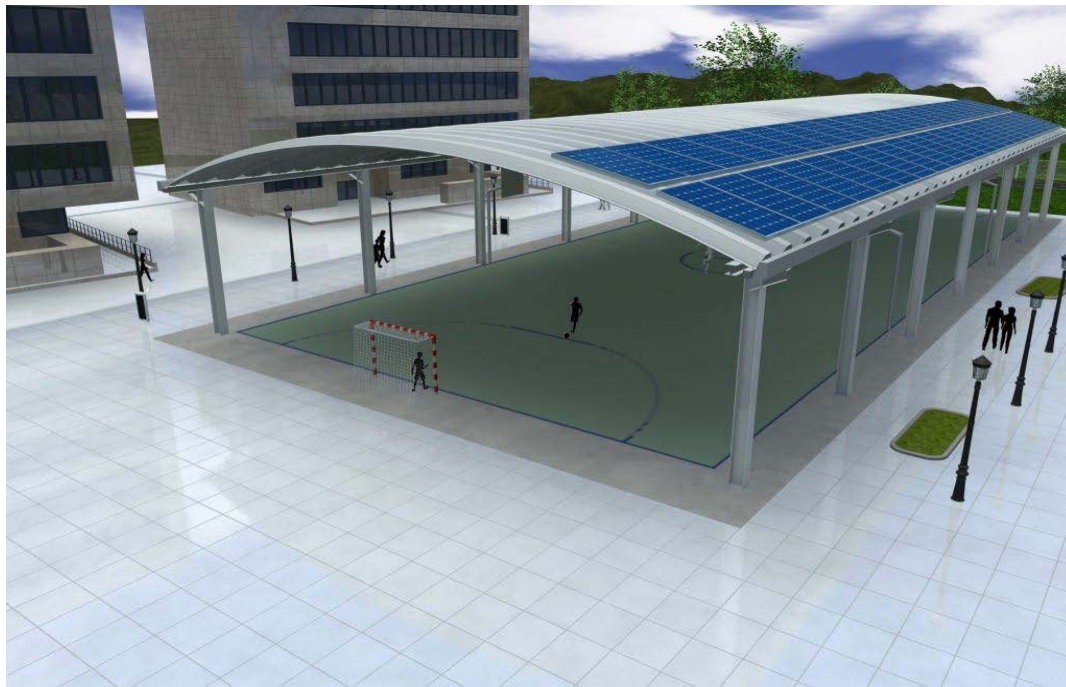
Standard Canopy (Option 3): the roof enclosure is constructed with translucent acrylic sheet and the sidings are profiled metal sheet, the lower 3m to ground level being open. This still provides excellent weather resistance and a clean, modern appearance, but enables further cost reduction.

Our canopy partner has been working on solar solutions for some years and can add photovoltaic units to the canopies in a number of ways. We are increasingly asked about the possibilities – it can all be done (but preferably with south facing roof pitches). 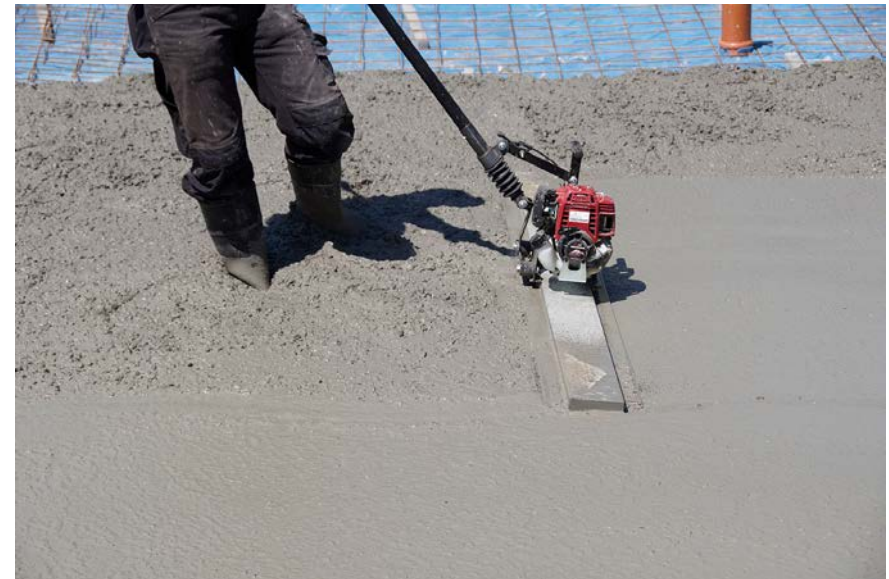
For every location...

A key point of differentiation for Padel Plus is providing ground works via our network of regional specialists.

Each padel court site must be evaluated on an individual basis with consideration for logistics (site location, movement of materials on and off site, ground conditions, presence of existing services or infrastructure). **We encourage site owners / operators to commission geotech surveys before contacting us** so all parties know from the outset what the likely project challenges will be.

Where a club or operator has an existing relationship with a contractor we will ensure they have the correct specification so the site is prepared to our needs.

We encourage customers with canopies to collect the rainwater (in underground tanks where appropriate) so the water can be used to irrigate any landscaping around the padel courts or adjacent sports facilities (football / rugby / cricket pitches).
