This Cookies Policy explains how VOLTOX GmbH (“Company”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on our websites <https://voltox.ai> (“Website”). It describes the types of cookies we use, the purposes for which we use them, and how you can manage your cookie preferences.

By continuing to browse our website, you agree to our use of cookies as described in this policy, unless you have disabled them in your browser settings.

I. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device when you visit a website. They help websites function properly, improve user experience, and provide analytics and marketing insights.

Cookies can be:

- Session cookies – deleted when you close your browser;
- Persistent cookies – remain on your device for a set period;
- First-party cookies – set by us directly;
- Third-party cookies – set by external service providers.

II. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

We use the following categories of cookies:

a) Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the proper functioning of our website and cannot be disabled.

Examples include:

- Managing your session
- Providing secure log-in
- Loading core site functionality

b) Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies collect information about how visitors use our websites, such as which pages are visited most often. We use this data to improve user experience.

Examples include: Google Analytics cookies (data is anonymized where possible).

c) Functional Cookies

These cookies remember your preferences and choices (e.g., language settings), providing a more personalized experience.

III. LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

- For Strictly Necessary Cookies – processing is based on our legitimate interest in ensuring the proper operation of the Websites (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).
- For all other cookies – processing is based on your consent (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR).

IV. THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

Some cookies on our website are set by third-party services that appear on our pages. These third parties may use cookies to collect information about your online activities over time and across different websites. We recommend checking their privacy policies for more information:

V. MANAGING YOUR COOKIE PREFERENCES

You can manage or disable cookies in several ways:

- Cookie Banner: Adjust your preferences through our on-site cookie settings tool.
- Browser Settings: Most browsers allow you to block or delete cookies. Please note that disabling cookies may affect the functionality of our website.
- Opt-Out Tools: Some services (e.g., Google Analytics) provide their own opt-out mechanisms.

VI. DATA RETENTION

We keep cookies for no longer than necessary for the purposes described in this policy. Retention times vary by cookie type and purpose; persistent cookies will be deleted after their expiry date or when you delete them manually.
