2. COOKIES

- 2.1. Cookies are small text files that a web browser stores on a computer or device when certain web pages are visited or specific actions are taken on the Company's website or other sites. They help the browser remember a visitor's preferences and display relevant information, such as items in the shopping cart, ensuring the visitor is not treated as a new user each time a page is accessed.
- 2.2. Some cookies, known as «session cookies» are stored only during a visit to help with website navigation and provide relevant content. Others, called «persistent cookies» are stored for

longer periods, allowing the browser to remember preferences from previous visits. Cookies are harmless to the device, anonymous, and unique to the user's browser.

3. COOKIES AND THEIR USE ON OUR WEBSITE

At Company, we use a variety of cookies and tracking technologies to improve, manage, and monitor the performance of our digital services. Below is a detailed overview of the types of cookies we use, their purposes, and how they enhance your interaction with our online services.

3.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

Strictly necessary cookies are essential for the proper functioning of a website. Without these cookies, the site would not operate properly. These cookies do not collect any personally identifiable information or monitor your browsing activity. They are critical for ensuring smooth website operation and enhancing user experience.

3.1.1. Purpose:

- **User authentication:** These cookies allow us to securely log you into our website and client platforms, and keep you logged in as you navigate through different pages.
- **Basic functionality:** They enable core features like page navigation, accessing secure areas, and using essential functionalities such as payment processing.
- **Content management:** These cookies assist in tasks like accurately filling out forms and managing content.
- **Privacy Management:** They help manage and maintain your privacy settings during your session, ensuring compliance with your preferences.

3.2. Analytical Cookies

3.2.1. Purpose:

_cfduid	1 month	A Cloudflare cookie that is used for security and performance optimization purposes. It helps to improve website speed by caching content, allowing quicker loading times. 5. MANAGING COOKIES

Firefox:

Go to «Preferences» > «Privacy & Security» > «Cookies and Site Data»

From there, you can block cookies, allow them, or set custom preferences. Firefox also offers enhanced tracking protection.

Internet Explorer:

Open «Internet Options» > «Privacy» > «Advanced»

Configure how first-party and third-party cookies are handled, or choose to block them. Safari:

Access «Preferences» > «Privacy»

Manage cookie settings to block all cookies, manage website data, or set site-specific preferences.

5.4. Certain mobile devices and tablets offer additional options for managing cookies. To access these options, check the "Privacy" or "Security" settings on your device. It's important to note that disabling cookies may affect the functionality of specific apps or websites.

5.5. While cookies enhance your browsing experience by remembering preferences and login information, blocking them can lead to issues:

6. COOKIE USAGE ON FIRST VISIT

6.1. When you visit our website for the first time, cookies are used to enhance your browsing experience.

These cookies help us understand how you interact with our digital services, allowing us to improve our website and offer more personalized content. Upon your initial visit, a cookie banner or notification will appear to inform you about the use of cookies and to request your consent for non-essential cookies.
