WHY THIS PROGRAM EXISTS

- Provide **free access** to sustainability experts and resources.
- Support companies with the greatest potential to **inspire change**.
- **Deliver flagship projects** that prove scalable impact is possible across the industry.

WHAT YOU RECEIVE DURING THE 10 MONTH PROGRAMME

BESPOKE SUSTAINABILITY SUPPORT

Hands-on consultancy with marine sustainability professionals supporting with lifecycle assessments, ESG strategy, sustainable materials advice, supply chain optimisation, or stakeholder education.

FUNDED INTERNSHIP

A fully funded 6-12 week internship brings fresh thinking and support from the next generation of sustainability leaders.

ACCESS TO THE MARINESHIFT360 LCA TOOL

A powerful, marine-specific tool for modeling the environmental impact of a single component or a full vessel. It helps identify hotspots, test design options, and reduce emissions.

COLLABORATIVE NETWORK

Join a community of innovators, suppliers, and change-makers. Share insights, learn from peers, and collaborate to accelerate sustainable solutions.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

01

IMMERSION

Stakeholder engagement, ESG maturity review, impact focus workshop

02

EDUCATION

Targeted workshops on ESG, carbon, sustainable supply chain, product design, and DEI.

03

STRATEGY

Development of a bespoke sustainability strategy linked to company mission and each organisations specific sustainability objectives.

04

IMPLEMENTATION

Rollout of actions such as LCAs, GHG inventories, waste strategies, renewable energy adoption, supported by a 3-month internship.

05

OPTIMISATION

Measurement, evaluation, and iteration of project success

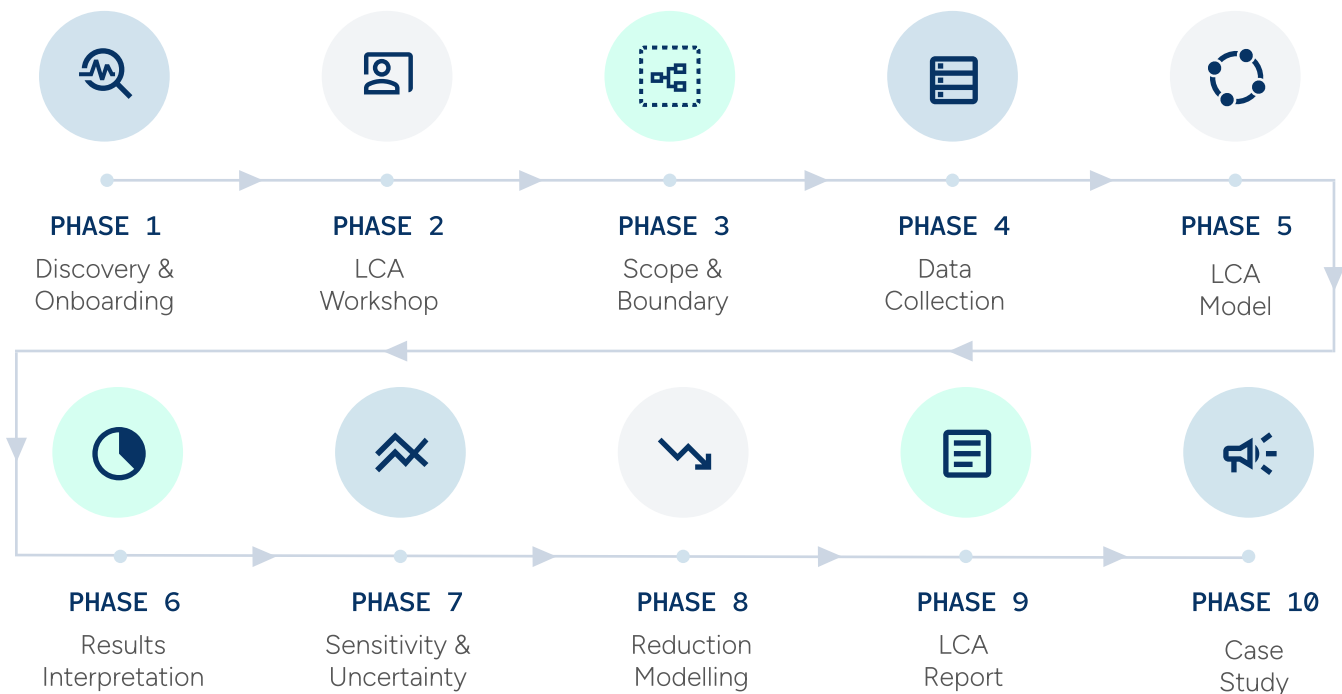

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

We are seeking marine companies and organisations with pioneering solutions, products, or processes that can genuinely reduce environmental impact.

Examples include:

- Zero-emission or low-impact vessels
- Innovative, low impact materials
- Sustainable manufacturing methods
- Circular economy or sustainable ownership models

We also welcome applications from organisations working to reduce the footprint of their operations & inspire systemic change.

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU

Participation is a two-way commitment. Successful applicants will:

- Dedicate time and resources for 10 months
- Provide an internal team to work with our experts and interns
- Be open to collaboration within the Accelerator community
- Share outcomes publicly to inspire sector-wide change
