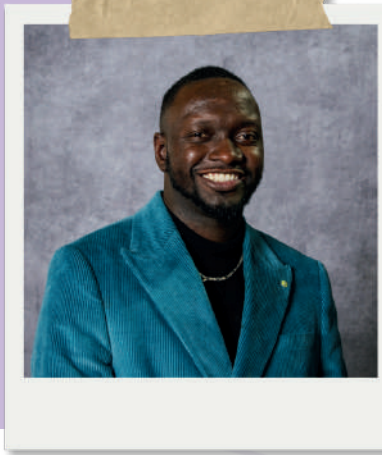
## INTSTRUCTION
