Caution: Pesticides are toxic chemicals. Structural pest control operators are licensed and regulated by the structural pest control board, and apply pesticides which are registered and approved for use by the California department of agriculture and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the state finds that based on existing scientific evidence there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized.

# What Should I Do?

A Few Do's and Don'ts for You and Your Family

DO	DON'T
Keep all people and pets out of a treated home for at least 4 hours after service.  *Not necessary to vacate if gel is used for ants or roaches.	Don't leave open food, dishes, toys, or pet dishes exposed during treatment.
Keep <b>pets</b> out of a treated <b>yard</b> for at least <b>2 hours</b> after service	Don't be alarmed if you see insects immediately after service. It takes a while for full control. See page 3 for specific information on timetables for each pest.
Keep toddlers and birds away from treated areas for at least 8 hours.	For roach treatments, don't wash kitchen shelves afterwards. It's important that the treatment remain in the cabinets to keep pests out. Use shelf paper.
If you are pregnant, have asthma or respiratory problems, or have a baby under one year old, ask your doctor whether you and your family should vacate the home for the first 24 hours following treatment.  We advise at least 8 and up to 24 hours under these special conditions.	Don't forget about your fish! Ideally, you should remove them from the home before treatment. If you can't, 1) Disconnect the aquarium power supply, and 2) cover the aquarium with a wet towel during treatment. This can help to reduce risks for your fish, but not eliminate them completely.
For roach and service, remove EVERYTHING from food cabinets and storage areas before treating for roaches; put items on a table or other large surface and cover with plastic before treatment.	Don't feed the pests! Vacuum regularly; don't leave food out where pests can get at it; clean up kitchen spills; don't leave dirty dishes in the sink. Follow-up will ensure they stay away
For fleas, vacuum thoroughly before treatment and have pets flea-bathed. Also vacuum aggressively for 2 - 3 weeks after treatment.	For Ants, don't be alarmed if you see <i>more</i> of them for a few days. This is normal for up to 14 days after treatment. Call if you have any questions at all.

Please note that **spiders** are not insects, and although some types of spiders respond to pesticides, usually we need to control them by eliminating their food supply—insects.

\*If you consistently hear a sound like a **cricket in the same spot**, check **your smoke alarm**. Sometimes smoke alarms chirp when they want a new battery.
