

# Data Capability 4: Reliable Movement Between Systems

**Domain:** Data (The Information)

**Capability:** Flow

**Core Mandate:** The ability to move important data safely, reliably, and efficiently between systems, teams, workflows, reports, automations, and AI Use Cases.

Remind the room: AI is a high-performance engine, but data flow is the fuel line. Today, we are diagnosing why the engine keeps stalling.



# The Transformation Ecosystem: Where Data Lives



**Leadership directs:** Sets the strategic mandate, risk posture, and decision rhythms.

**Data informs (You Are Here):** Provides the fuel for insight. Must be owned, trusted, and accessible.

**Technology enables:** Ensures AI solutions are secure, integrated, and reliable.

**Factory produces:** Turns ideas into measured value using evidence gates.

**People adopt:** Helps teams understand, adapt to, and sustain the new ways of working.

# The Value Chain of Information: Step 4 is Movement



## 1. Ownership assigns

You cannot ensure quality if no one is accountable.

## 2. Quality proves

You cannot safely grant access to inaccurate data.

## 3. Access enables

You cannot flow information if security boundaries are unknown.

## 4. Flow connects (Focus Area)

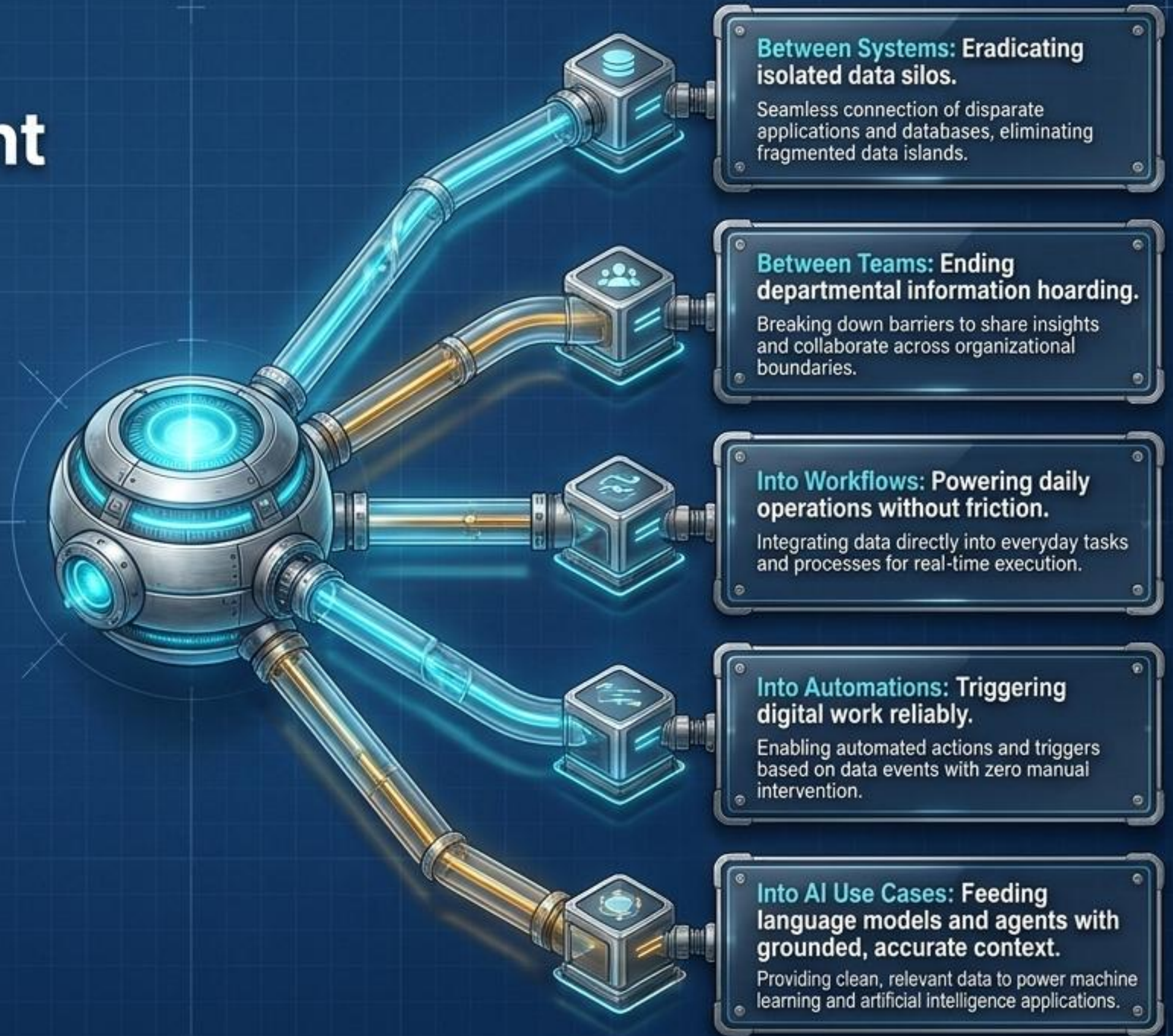
You cannot generate insights if data is trapped in silos.

## 5. Insight informs

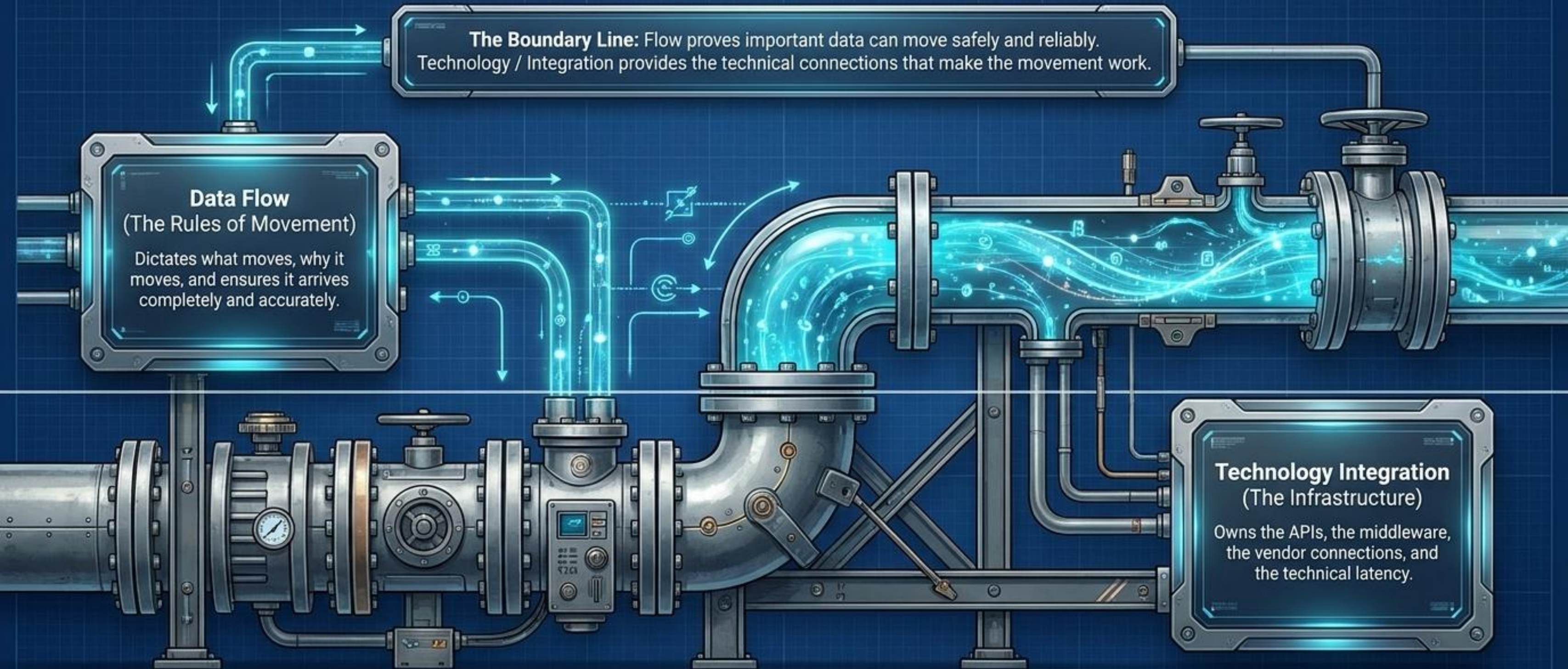
The ultimate combustion of data into business value.

**The Definition:**  
Flow is the organization's ability to move important data safely, reliably, and efficiently.

# Distinguishing the Information from the Infrastructure

## Technology Integration (T3)



**Focus:**

The technical connection.



**Owns:**

APIs, middleware, system bridges, vendor gateways.



**Measures:**

Latency, uptime, system-to-system ping, technical failure rates.



**Failure looks like:**

"The API timed out."

## Data Flow (D4)



**Focus:**

The information payload.



**Owns:**

The map of what moves, avoidance of manual spreadsheet handoffs, data reconciliation.



**Measures:**

Accuracy, completeness, timeliness of the payload.



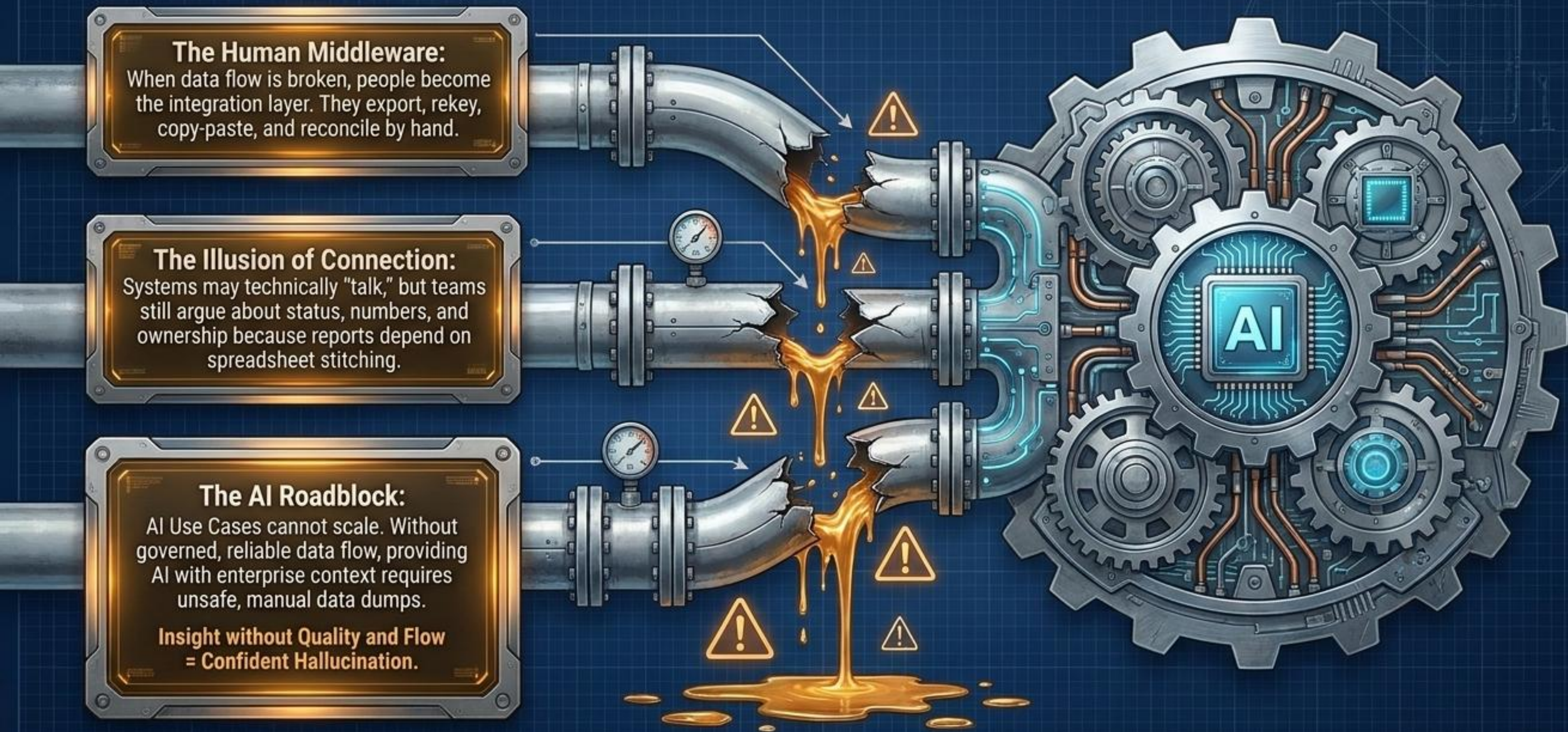
**Failure looks like:**

"The system connected, but the report is missing half the customer records."

### Architect's Note

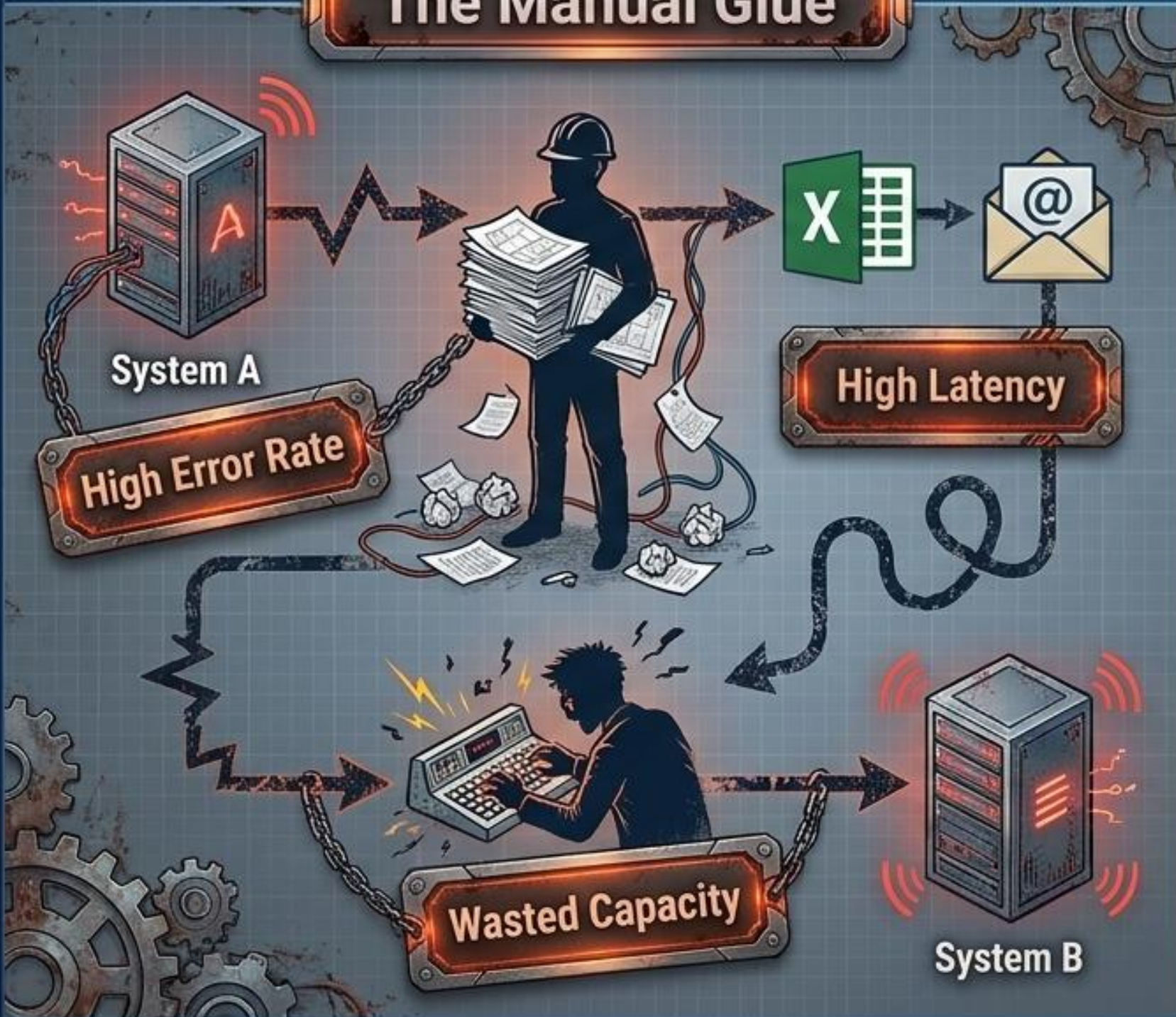
Remind the room: You can have perfect Technology Integration and terrible Data Flow. A perfectly built pipe that pumps contaminated water is a failure.

# The Friction: Why Disconnected Data Breaks Transformation

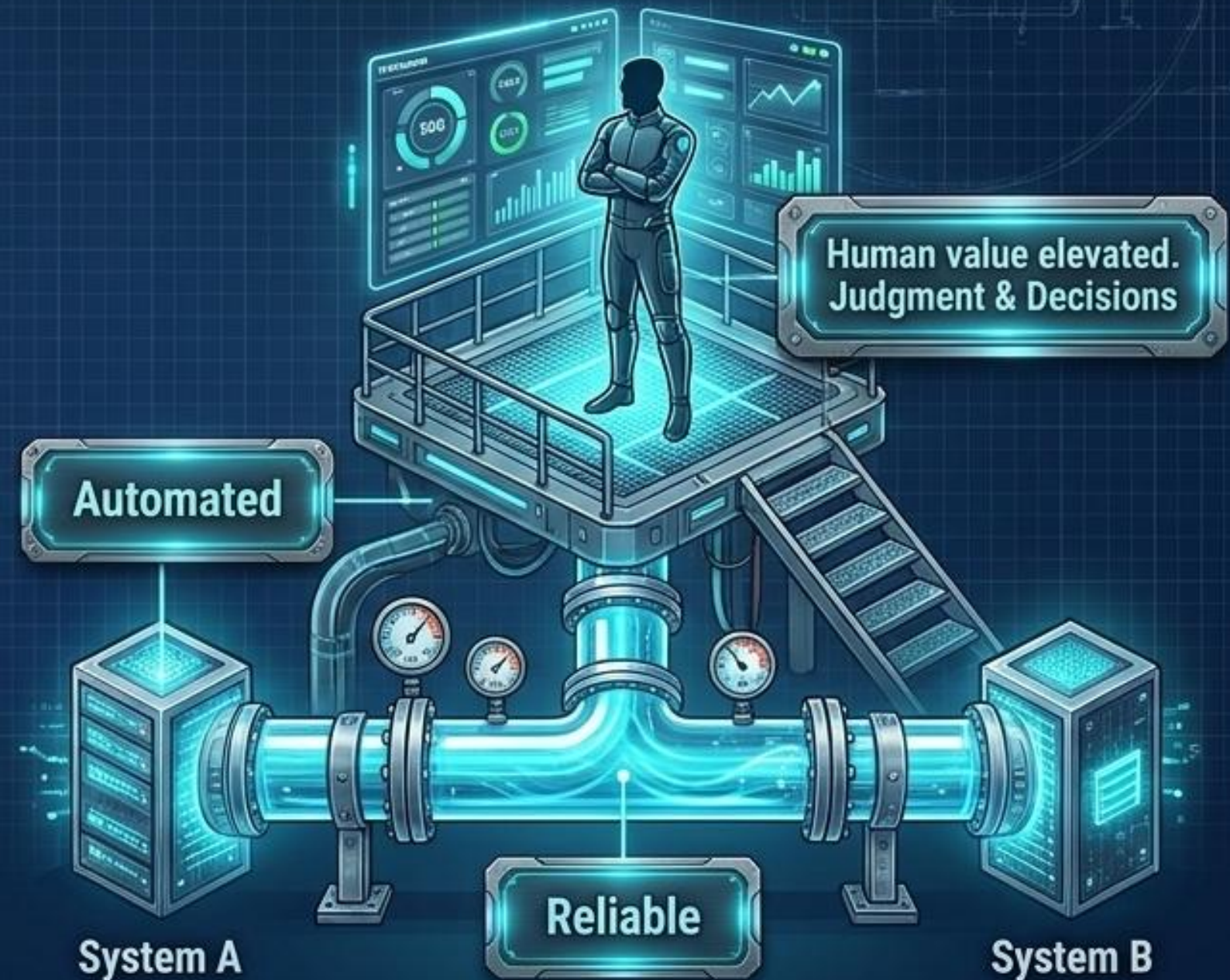


# Escaping “Manual Glue” as an Operating Model

# Executive Evidence: Proving the Capability Exists

**The Mandate:** Do not measure aspiration. Measure artifacts, operating reality, and reduced friction.

**Key 1: Visibility**  
(Mapped Data Flows)

**Key 2: Efficiency**  
(Reduced Manual  
Re-entry)

To unlock true Data Flow maturity, leaders must demand three specific pieces of executive evidence:



**Key 3: Trust**  
(Monitoring &  
Reconciliation)

# Evidence Rule 1: Mapped Data Flows

## The Rule

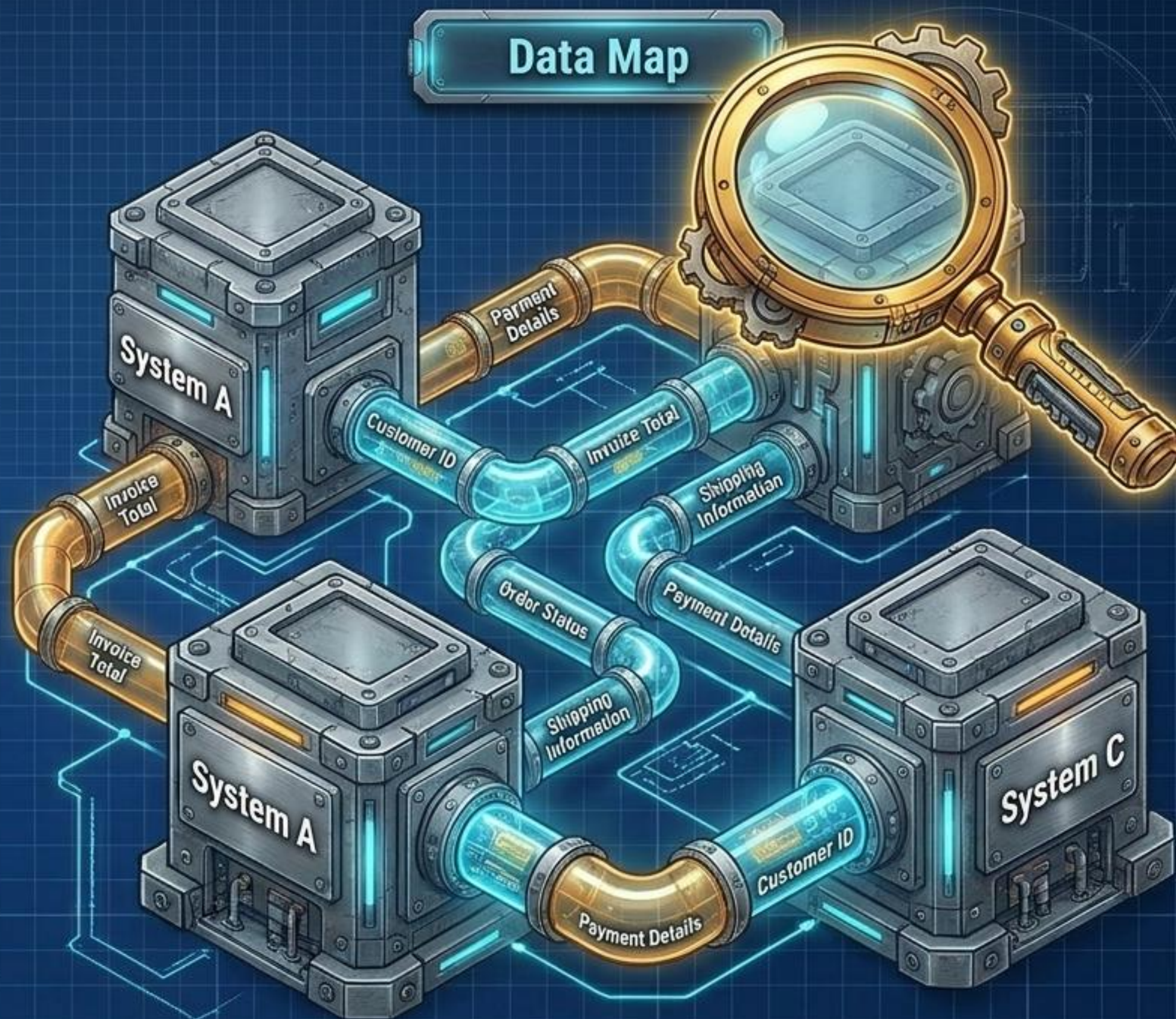
Mapped data flows for priority processes, reports, automations, or AI Use Cases.

## What it proves (Visibility)

The organization understands exactly what information is moving, where it originates, and where it lands.

## The Warning

This is not a generic IT network diagram. It is a specific map of the information payload required to make priority business decisions or feed a specific AI model.



# Evidence Rule 2: Eradicated “Human Middleware”

## The Rule

Reduced manual re-entry, spreadsheet handoffs, or duplicate data movement.

## What it proves (Efficiency)

Integration and Flow are actually removing real operational friction from the business.



## The Litmus Test

Ask the frontline teams: “Where are you still forced to export, copy, paste, or reconcile by hand to do your daily work?”



# Evidence Rule 3: Unshakable Reconciliation

## The Rule

Monitoring or reconciliation showing important data moves completely, accurately, and on time.

## What it proves (Trust)

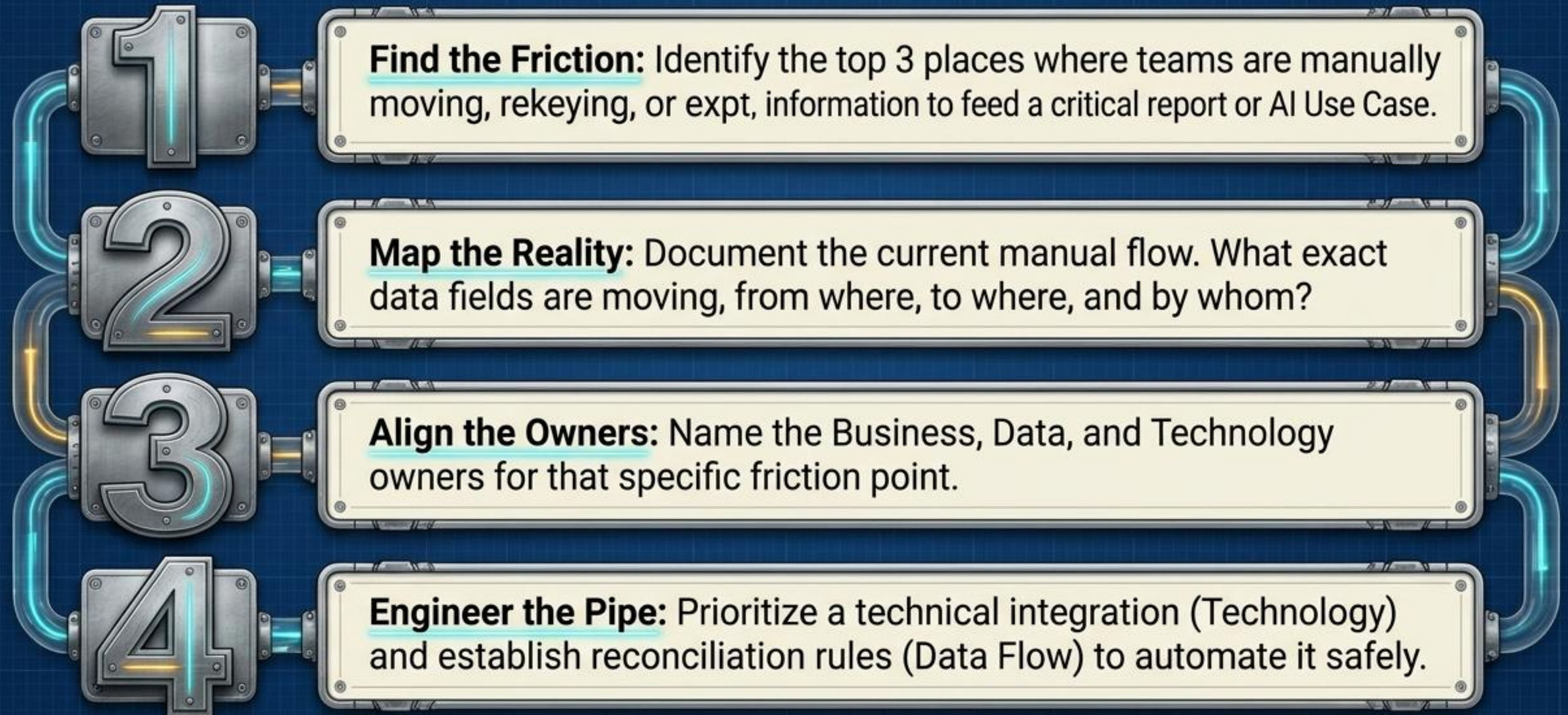
Leaders can make decisions, and AI agents can execute actions, based on the absolute certainty that the data is correct.

## The Artifact

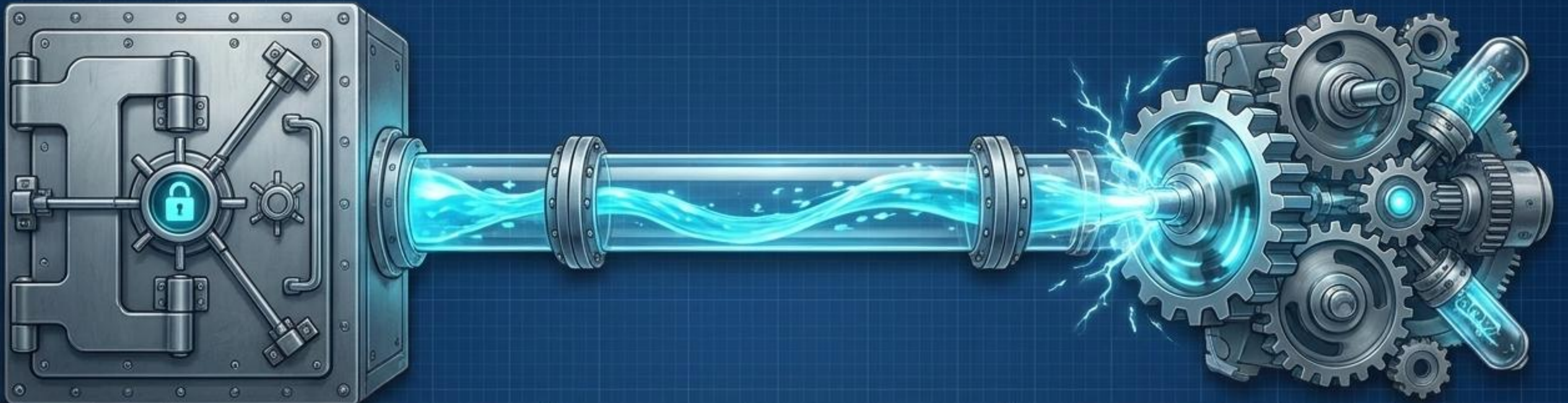
Recurring automated checks that compare the source system to the target system to ensure zero data loss or corruption during transit.
