Upon successful Housing Needs Assessment training, Fieldworkers will be ready to take on the following tasks as part of this local Inuit initiative:

- Making initial contact with survey participants;
- Responding to questions community members may have about the Housing Needs Assessment survey or about their participation;
- Using tablets to conduct the consent procedure and administer survey questionnaires at personal residences;
- Scheduling appointments to administer the Housing Needs Assessment in a private space where one-on-one confidentiality can be ensured;
- Ensuring information collected is protected after data collection
- Performing other related duties as required.
