Banco Santander has historically offered global payment solutions, although the Getnet brand has evolved uniquely in each geography.

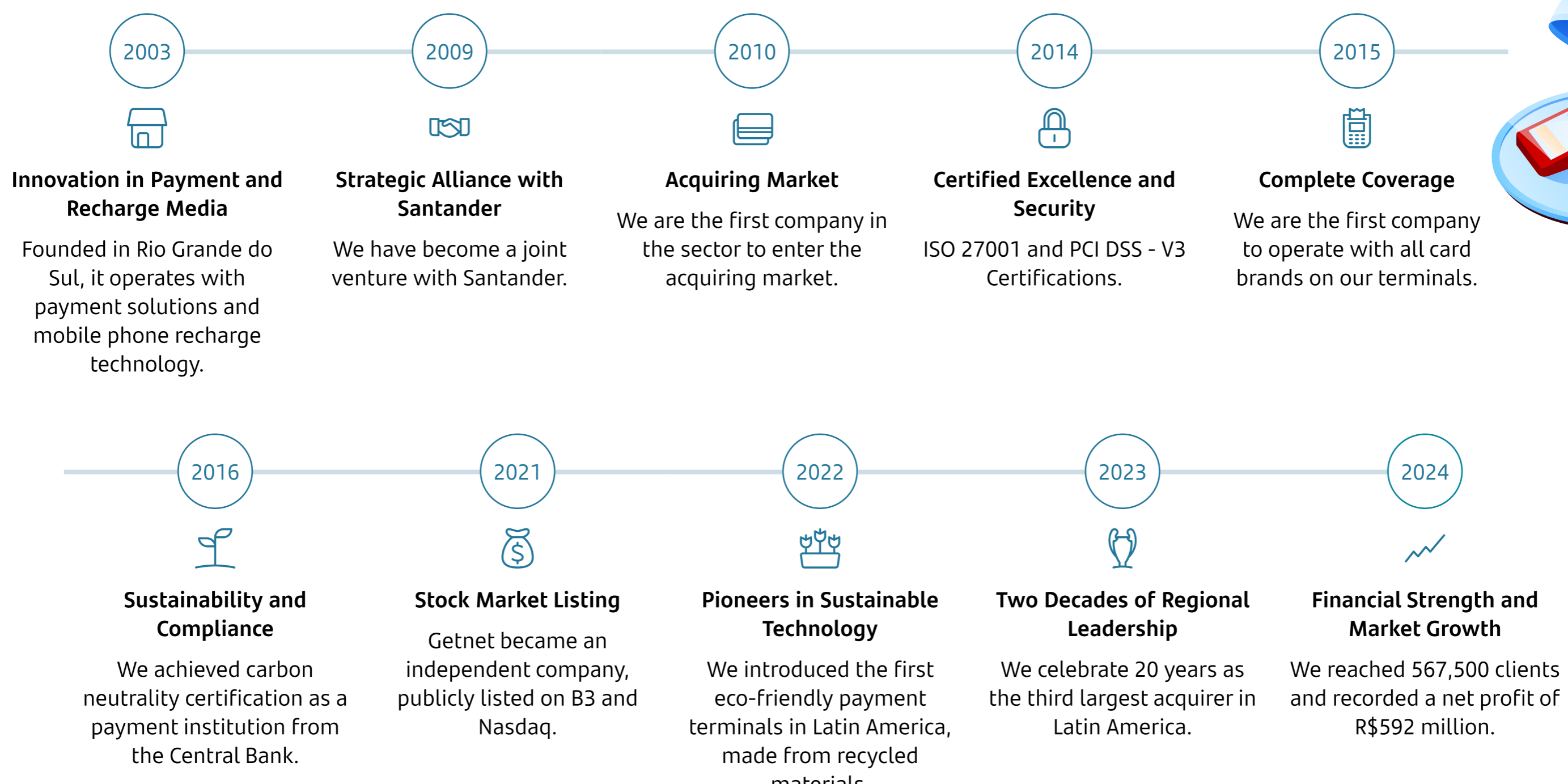
Its trajectory combines the integration of previous partnership models with the acquisition of native technology companies according to the needs of each market.

Currently, these trajectories converge into a unified global platform that enhances local agility with the scale of the Group.



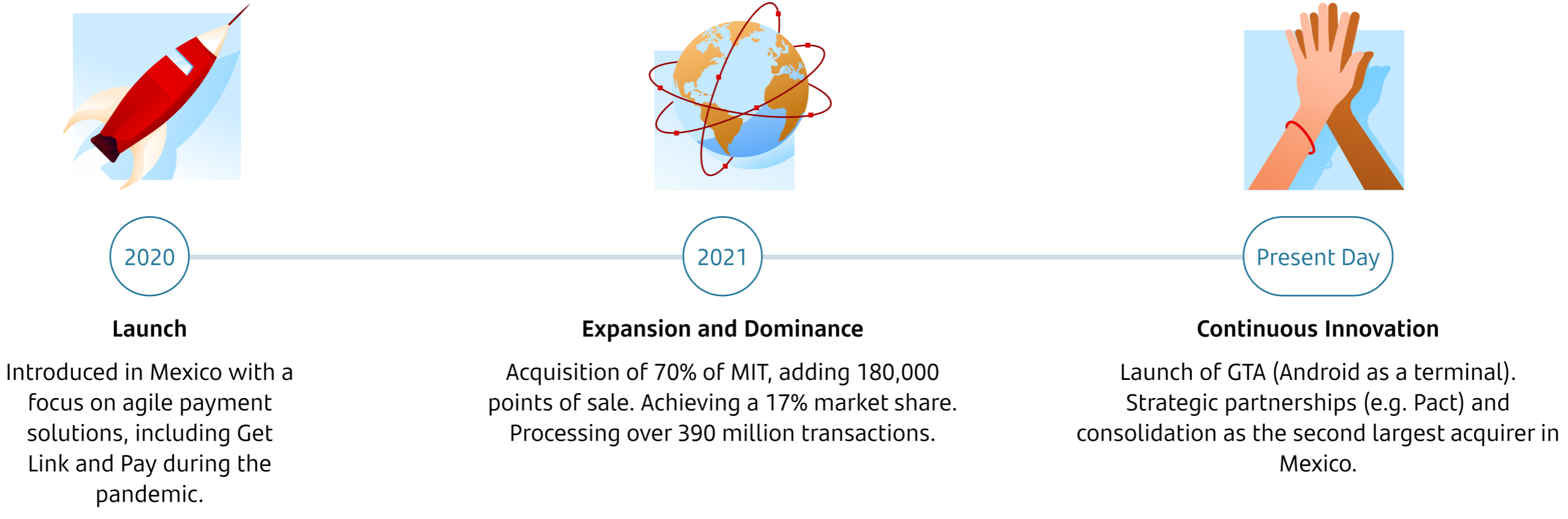

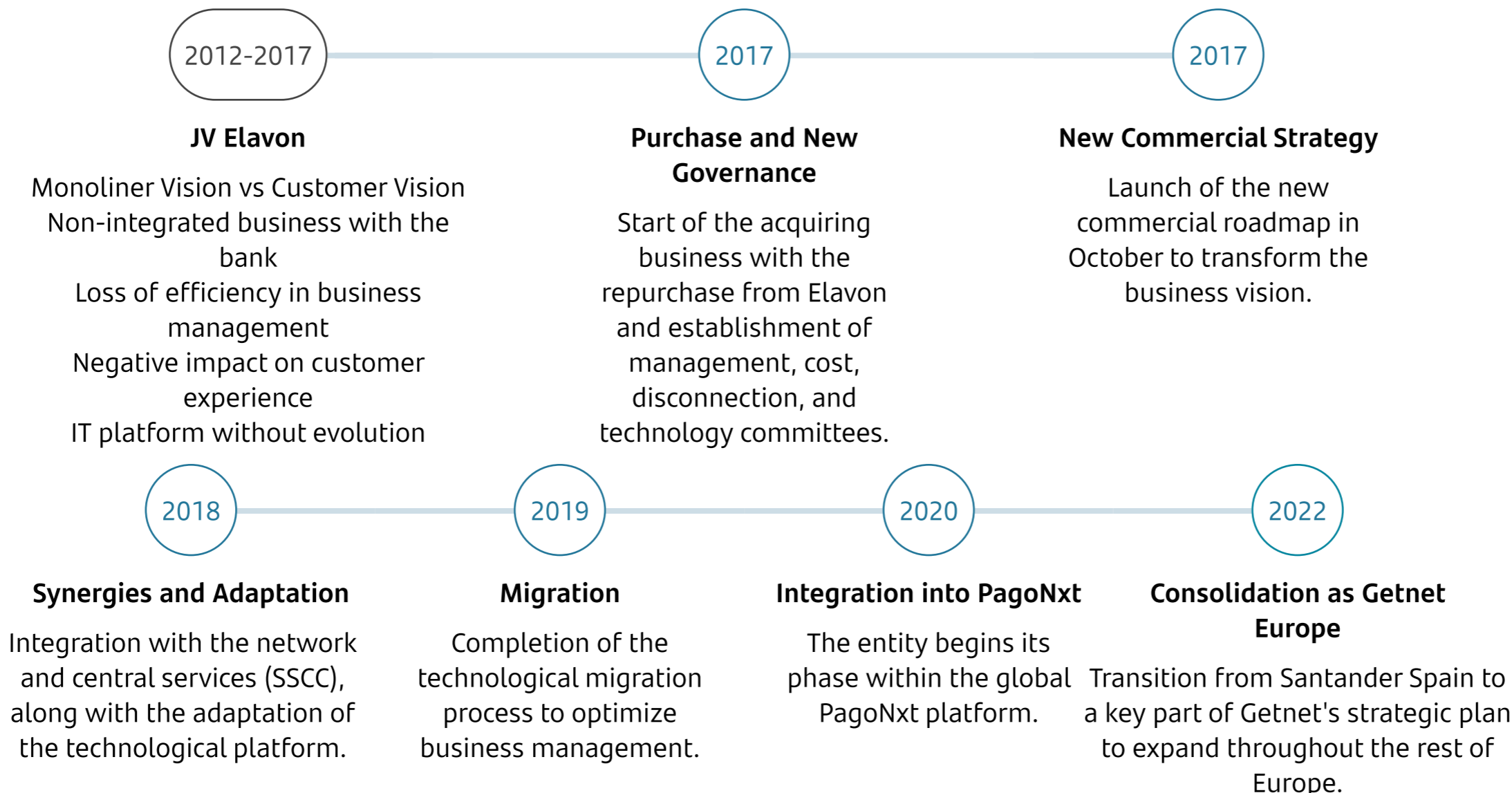
MÉXICO

Getnet Mexico, launched by Grupo Santander in 2020, is a key acquiring technology platform in the digitalisation of payments for businesses of all sizes, quickly establishing itself as the second most important player in the sector in Mexico. As part of PagoNxt (a Santander fintech), it offers physical and digital solutions including terminals (Smart, Mini, Advance) and contactless payments.



EUROPA

The acquiring business in Spain began in 2017 after the repurchase of the business that had been operating as a joint venture with Elavon since 2012. This operation allowed Santander to regain direct management of a strategic activity. From then on, an entity was established that operated within Santander Spain until 2022, the year it was integrated into PagoNxt with the aim of driving its expansion throughout the rest of Europe.



ARGENTINA

In Argentina, Getnet was launched in 2020 with a focus on small businesses, initially offering Aparato and Payment Link as acceptance solutions. In this first stage, the model relied on Geopagos as a payment facilitator, allowing for a quick market entry. Subsequently, the operation evolved into a scheme supported by Getnet's own platform, expanding its offering with digital integrations, interoperable QR, and Smart POS terminals to serve both SMEs and larger companies.
