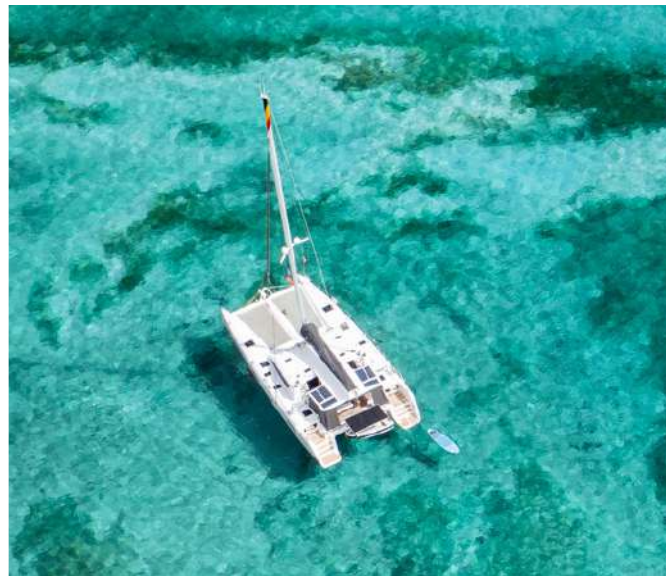




The rally of a lifetime

GLYWO 500

In 2021, right in the middle of the COVID period, the first World Odyssey started with more than 30 crews representing 13 nationalities. The aim was to celebrate the first circumnavigation of the globe under sail by Magellan and El Cano 500 years earlier.

After the first transatlantic, which immediately got the crews into the swing of things, the fleet clocked up the miles as each country reopened its doors to travelers. With over 35,000 miles sailed by June 2024, they complete their circumnavigation in the Azores.

The highlight of the first edition's participants are numerous: Cartagena in Colombia, Polynesia, Vanuatu, Namibia... you'll discover their tips, recommendations and good addresses in the roadbook that will be given to each participant at the start of the World Odyssey 25.

Criteria

Registration for the World Odyssey is open to all, subject to :

- Own a GLY brand boat (Allures, Outremer, Garcia, Gunboat, RM, ORC).
- A minimum of 7 nights at sea. ■ A minimum of two people on board for each crossing.
- To have taken a long-distance cruise training course (given during the preparation week).
- Have already sailed a minimum of 1500 nm, including a 500 nm crossing on your own boat or equivalent.
