



How do we receive the Global Leadership Summit (GLS)?

The GLS is streamed online through our partner, Sardi Media, using their specialized platform to ensure high-quality streaming for all our sites. We provide training videos, looping, and live test content throughout the summer to help you prepare for the GLS.

How do we make sure our site can stream the GLS?

Test Your Internet Bandwidth

- Run a bandwidth test: <https://www.speakeasy.net/speedtest/>
- We recommend a minimum download speed of 15 Mbps.
- We recommend using a dedicated hardwired connection for your streaming computer or device. Wi-Fi is not advised for streaming.

Make sure your computer meets the minimum specifications.

- Windows 11 or macOS 11
- Latest Version of Chrome or Firefox Browser.
- 8Gb RAM
- HDMI or SDI Output

What should we use to present the GLS at our site?

The GLS spans 2 days, with approximately 8 hours of content each day. As you prepare, consider the number of attendees and the room size. To provide the best viewing experience, ask yourself: what setup will be most effective? Below are the recommended minimum specifications and some common pitfalls to avoid.

Recommended To Use:

Projector: A 6,000-7,000 lumens projector that is native HD (laser or DLP).
Screen: 16:9 widescreen with a trim kit (front or rear projection)
Screen Size: 9ft x 16ft minimum size
Location: One screen, center of viewing area.

What systems does the GLN not recommend using at our site?

We do not support playback via ProPresenter, as ProPresenter 7 is incompatible with most modern web browsers, including our web player.

What training and support does the GLN offer as the GLS approaches?

In preparation for the GLS, we offer a range of resources for your site, including essential training videos, informational downloads, required live and looped testing content, and a dedicated team ready to support you during GLS week.
