2024 WAS A TURNAROUND YEAR FOR THE GLOBAL LEADERSHIP NETWORK – equipping hundreds of thousands of leaders while achieving missional clarity and financial stability.

More than 365,000 leaders were equipped across 100 countries — including in churches, businesses, prisons and communities hungry for transformation — through the Global Leadership Summit and year-round initiatives. The Summit sold out at its broadcast location, and hundreds of churches and other organizations hosted Summits to raise up local leaders. We also launched Base Camp, a new event designed to pour into pastors whose churches host the Summit, helping them lead stronger, healthier communities of faith.

We're not just growing in reach; we're also returning to our roots. In 2024, we took meaningful steps to re-center on our original calling: to equip leaders to point people to Jesus. We renewed our focus on strengthening churches, investing in pastors and elevating leaders who carry the message of hope into every sphere of society.

Of course, we also faced serious challenges. In recent years, we've operated at a loss of millions of dollars per year. But thanks to the generosity of our donors and intentional expense reductions, we've closed that financial gap. By God's grace, we ended the year just 1.5% away from breaking even — a significant turnaround and an encouraging sign of long-term sustainability.

What's most exciting? We're no longer focused on just surviving. Our team is now asking: How do we build on this momentum? How can we multiply impact and deepen transformation in the lives of leaders around the world?

Thank you for being part of this story. Together, we are planting seeds of change — seeds that will grow and bear fruit in ways we may not fully see for years to come.

CLARITY STARTS WITH OPEN COMMUNICATION.

With churches more engaged than ever and our core message of Jesus-infused leadership resonating strongly, GLS 2024 set the stage for a bold future — one where seeds planted this year will blossom into enduring impact.



GLS24 EMPOWERS INNOVATIVE LEADERS FIGHTING HUMAN TRAFFICKING

The anti-trafficking world is full of passion — but it's also full of pressure. Staff burnout, high turnover and emotional fatigue are common. But according to Kristi Wells, CEO of Safe House Project, the root issue isn't burnout. It's leadership.

"This industry is full of founders who feel called to do this work," says Kristi. "But sometimes they forget that God also brings other people along. We don't have to have all the answers."

Safe House Project, a survivor care nonprofit co-founded by Kristi Wells and Brittany Dunn, has built leadership into its DNA. Both women bring deep leadership experience to their roles — Kristi grew up surrounded by Fortune 500 CEOs; Brittany holds an MBA from Thunderbird School of Global Management. Together, they've cultivated a culture built on empowerment, candor and shared leadership.

"We push for extreme outcomes," Kristi says, "because everybody in their respective roles has extreme ownership."

And it's working. In 2023, they served 534 survivors. But in 2024, they set an audacious goal: nearly triple that number. "For that to happen, every part of the organization had to be working at full speed," Kristi shares. By the end of New Year's Eve, they had served 1,529 survivors.

That kind of growth doesn't happen by accident. In 2024, Kristi and Brittany are intentional about developing themselves and their team. In 2024, they attended the Global Leadership Summit in South Barrington, IL, seeking clarity for a daunting next step.

They had long seen the need for a better way to report human trafficking. Existing platforms were outdated and too many people in danger weren't getting help. The solution they envisioned — an innovative, secure reporting app — felt overwhelming.

"We were standing on the cusp of doing something really insane and innovative," Kristi recalls. "We were scared, thinking, if we do this, there's no turning back."

But a message at the Summit gave them the clarity and conviction they needed. Hearing Craig Groeschel speak about giving yourself "permission to obsess" helped them step fully into their WHALE — Whole-Hearted Allencompassing Life Endeavor.

"Sometimes to change the world, you have to do the hard things," Kristi says. "Greatness isn't found in the middle; it's born in the extremes."

This fall, Safe House Project will launch **Simply Report** — a first-of-its-kind app designed to empower safe, discreet reporting of human trafficking.

And they're not going it alone. In 2025, Kristi and Brittany are bringing their full team to the Summit.

"The Summit was unbelievable," Kristi says. "It's the place you go to get your leadership love tank filled up."

Their story is a powerful reminder: The world doesn't just need good intentions. It needs equipped, inspired leaders willing to take bold, faithful steps toward lasting change. That's exactly why the Summit exists — to inspire and equip leaders to rise to this challenge and make a meaningful difference in their communities and beyond.

GLS IN PRISONS

GLS in Prisons brings world-class leadership training to men and women behind bars — offering dignity, hope and the tools needed to lead positive change both during and after incarceration.

2024 IMPACT:

- 190+ correctional facilities streamed the GLS
- 20,000 inmates reached
- Partnerships with 30 states to bring the GLS to inmates
- Launched the Global Leadership Academy, a peer-led cohort experience bringing practical, faith-based tools to incarcerated men and women

REV. GABRIEL MAKAN — NIGERIA

After eight years in public office, Rev. Gabriel Makan was praying about how to serve his community in a deeper way when he was invited to attend and help host the Global Leadership Summit in his city. In a region marked by violent conflict and displacement, Gabriel brought GLS to children living in orphanages — many of whom had lost one or both parents to war. Through stories of resilience, leadership and healing, these young people began to rediscover their sense of identity, purpose and worth.

RONNY ALFARO — COSTA RICA

As a youth pastor in Costa Rica, Ronny Alfaro was passionate about reaching the next generation, but he felt overwhelmed and uncertain about how to scale his impact. At the Summit, something shifted. He encountered fresh inspiration and practical leadership principles that re-energized his mission. Since then, Ronny has expanded his work into schools and underserved neighborhoods, using GLS content to equip young leaders and spark lasting change in their communities.


The Global Leadership Network's (GLN) 2024 financial performance was a testament to a disciplined and focused determination to turnaround significant deficits of prior years. We ended the year with a modest pre-depreciation operating loss of \$236,000. We thank God for the financial reserves built over many years that sustained us—and for the generous donors and partners who stood with us.

For 2024, revenue from the Global Leadership Summit and donor contributions increased by \$2.0 million (+15%) over the prior year. Concurrently, expenses were reduced by \$3.2 million (17%) through increased collaboration and creativity. The entire GLN team contributed to the amazing 2024 financial result.


