Sewon



Project Sewon will be wrapping up soon as is the biggest Tilt job on the books to date. The Tilt team once again pulled out the seemingly impossible on a complicated job! The overhead view of the job consisted of: 101 spread footings, 3,563 LF of continuous footing, 432,425 SF of slab on grade concrete, 30,008 SF of office slab on grade, 84,925 SF of smooth finish tilt panels, 200,872 SF of concrete pave, 18,461 SF of non reinforced casting bed, 418 TNS of rebar, 72,659 SF of slab on grade in the press pit, 9,112 SF of mat foundation—18,778 SF of 12" thick concrete wall, 9,654 SF of 18" CIP elevated lid. To say the least GGC is grateful to have the opportunity to build this job with Evans General Contractors. The GGC team has received many accolades for their stellar performance from the Evans Operations Team over the life of the project. This performance has continued on our relationship with Evans that is already building momentum on the next round of project awards.
