3. How We Collect Your Data

We collect personal data when you:

4. Purpose and Legal Basis for Processing

Your personal data is processed for the following purposes:

5. Marketing Communications

We will only send marketing communications where you have **explicitly consented**. You may withdraw your consent at any time by clicking the unsubscribe link or contacting us directly.

6. Data Retention

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, including legal, accounting, or reporting requirements.

7. Data Sharing

We do not sell your personal data.

Your data may be shared with trusted third parties only where necessary, such as:

- Website hosting providers
- Email marketing platforms
- IT and security service providers

All third parties are required to comply with GDPR.

8. Data Transfers Outside the EU

If personal data is transferred outside the European Economic Area (EEA), we ensure appropriate safeguards are in place, such as Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission.

9. Your Rights

Under GDPR, you have the right to:

- Access your personal data
- Rectify inaccurate data
- Request erasure (“right to be forgotten”)
- Restrict processing
- Data portability

- Object to processing
- Withdraw consent at any time

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority (Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali).
