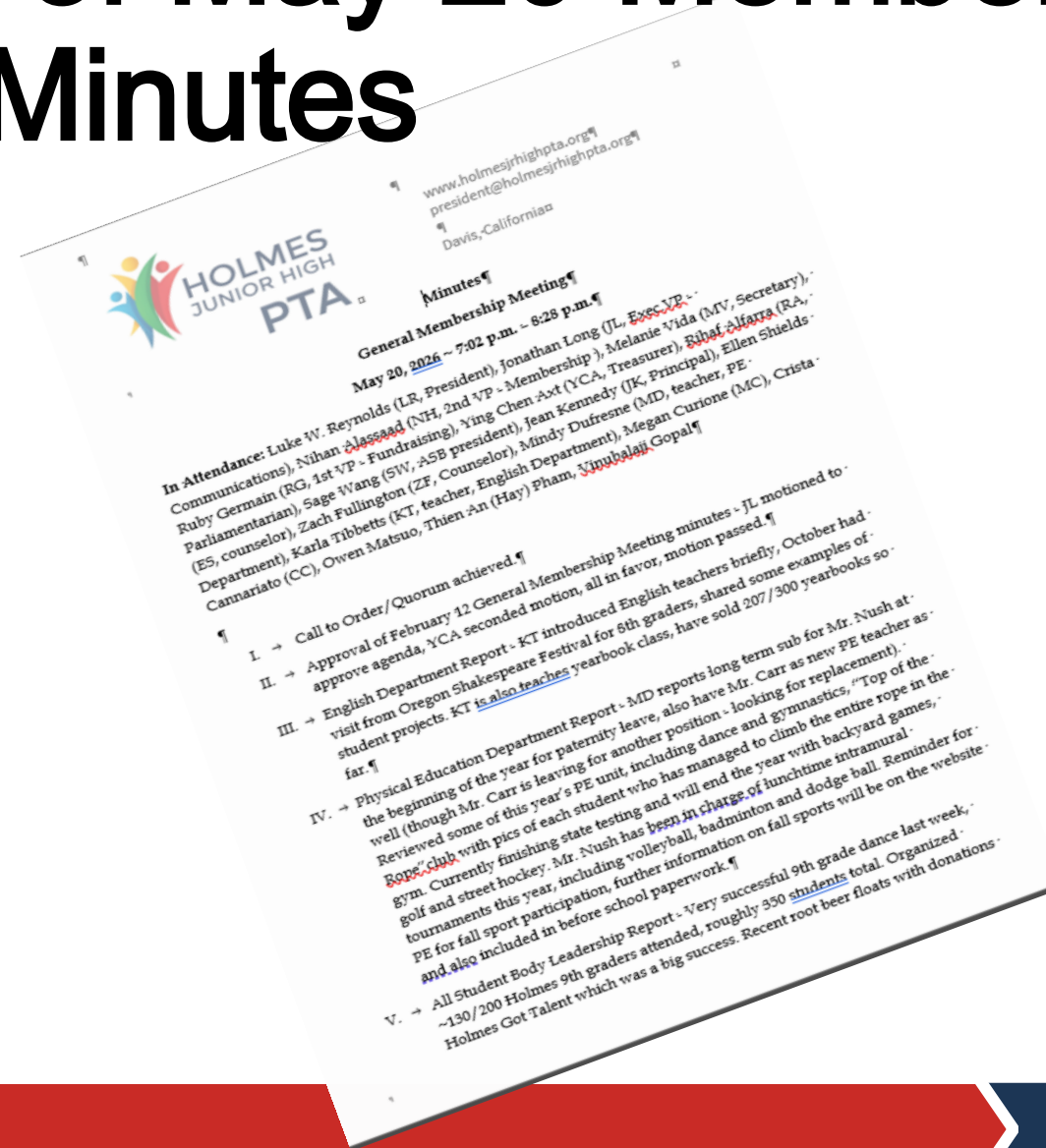
Our Mission Statement

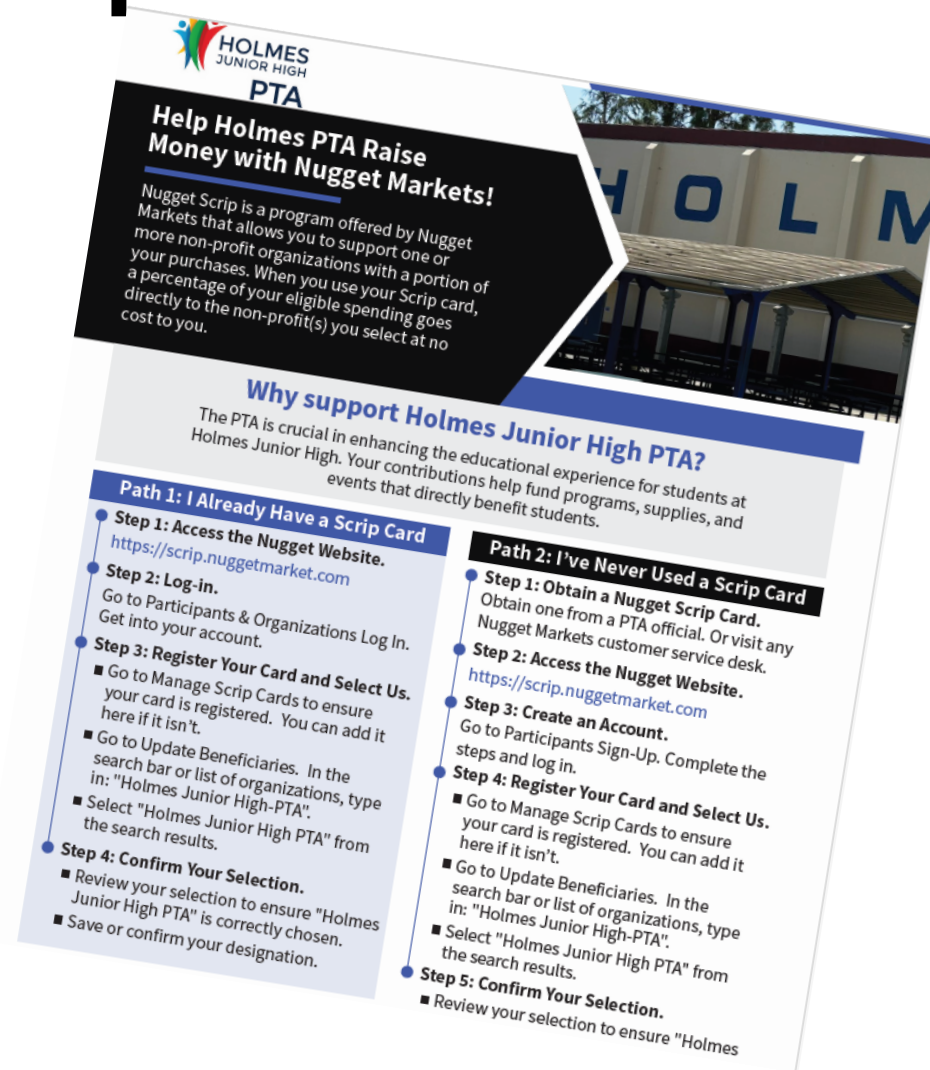
Budget Status at a Glance: Income

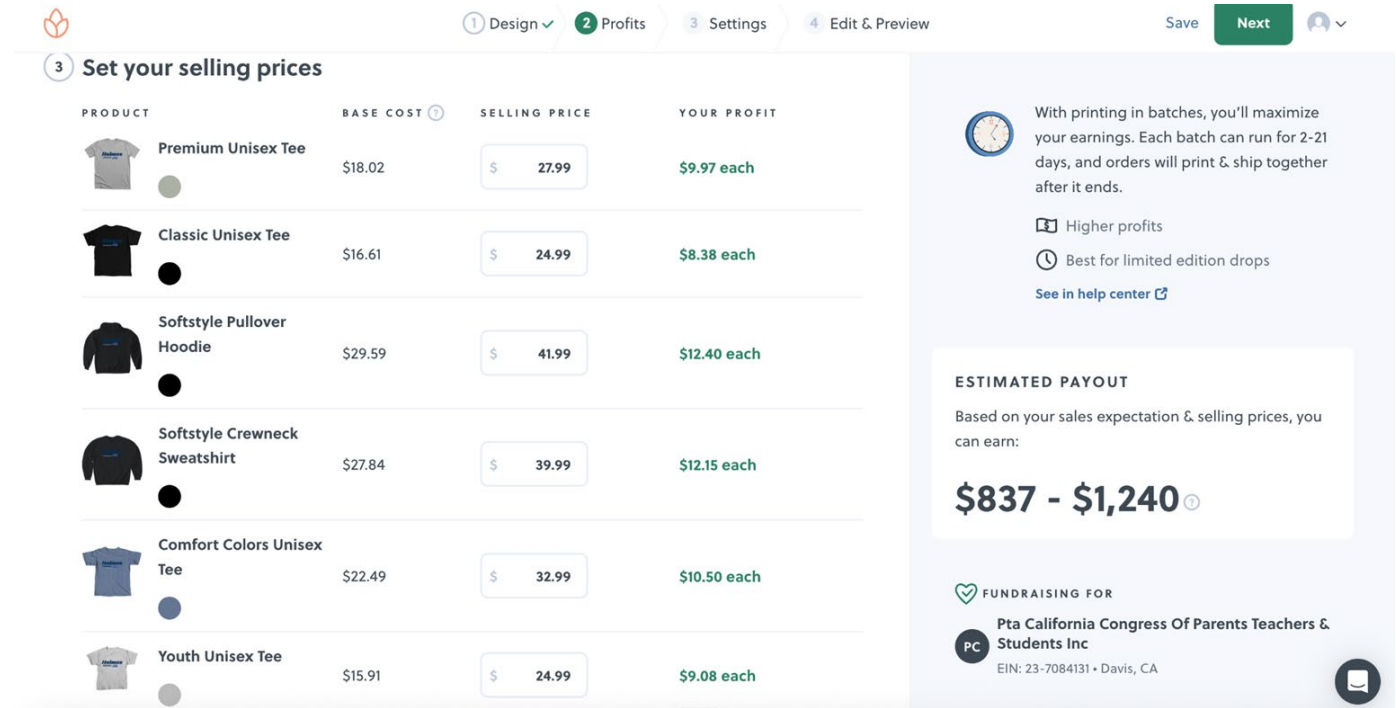
