Among the sites we will explore are Munich's famous onion-domed Frauenkirche, the world-renowned concert hall, Dachau Concentration Camp, Augustiner Brauerei (a seven-hundred-year-old brewery), as well as Nuremberg's Imperial Castle, Nazi Party Rally Grounds Museum, Nuremberg Trial Museum, and ancient old-town markets.

Bavaria is home to iconic folklore, music, geographic panoramas, food, and history that have become synonymous with modern Germany. From the snow-capped peaks that define its alpine border with Austria, to the beer gardens, lederhosen, and apple strudel that entice travelers on a daily basis, Bavaria is the very embodiment of the German phrase "Herzlichen Willkommen!"
