The heart of the initial phase of **IN PURSUIT**, an initiative of **More Perfect**, is a collection of short essays (only 1,250 words) written by some of our nation's most respected historians, journalists, and thought leaders. Each essay will focus on the leadership of an American President or First Lady and will surface practical, accessible lessons we can learn from successes, failures, and challenges that reflect upon the values, ideals and character of our nation.

American history has become a third rail, and consequently, In Pursuit is a leading nonpartisan national history-based civics initiative planned for 2026. The goal of In Pursuit is to inspire reflective patriotism, while disseminating knowledge about our past relevant for our future.

Drawing on partnerships of More Perfect from 37 Presidential Centers, the First Ladies Initiative at American University, iCivics, the Bill of Rights Institute, State Humanities Councils, and many other like-minded organizations, In Pursuit has a goal of reaching 10 million Americans, including 5 million students. The project begins with a series of essays and is designed to encourage efforts from students, educators, scholars, and leaders across sectors to tap into lessons from the past that can inform our future.
