The Life and Ministry of Jesus — Part I - Syllabus

Course Text(s): *Walking in the Dust of Rabbi Jesus*, Lois Tverberg
The Holy Bible

Course Description:

Jesus is the central figure of both the Old Testament and the New Testament. ***The Life and Ministry of Jesus*** will focus on the life of our Lord Jesus Christ as an example for Christians to emulate. The course will examine some of the events of His life and the markings of His ministry. Students will examine the four gospels, which are the primary biblical source of Jesus and His ministry. Jesus is God in the flesh and was sent to the lost sheep of the house of Israel to reaffirm the Abrahamic Covenant and to bring a New and better Covenant to man. This study will also include a basic description of the Jewish Jesus and the importance of understating His role as a rabbi, then and now.

Course Objectives and Goals:

To provide an outline of the life and some teachings of Jesus Christ and survey the events in His earthly ministry

Class Methodology of Teaching:

1. Class lectures
2. Student interaction
3. Reading, textbook assignments
4. Biblical and extra-biblical study projects (as assigned)
5. Question and answer opportunities

Course Requirements:

1. Participate in classroom discussions.
