## **Communion With God**

Syllabus

### Course Text(s): Dialogue with God, Mark and Patti Virkler L.E.A.R.N. workbook (4 Keys to Hearing God) The Holy Bible

#### **Course Description:**

God has created you for fellowship and a continuous relationship with Him through a life of communion with Him. Communion involves communication between you and God. This course will help you know and recognize His voice on a regular basis. The principles you will learn will help unlock the visionary nature with which you were created. God intends that you converse with Him in prayer and learn to recognize the sound of His voice. Understand how God will turn His written word *(logos)* into revelation *(rhema)* for your life.

#### Course Objectives and Goals:

- Understand your relationship with God is one of fellowship as you enjoy conversation, communication, and communion with Him
- You were created to hear the voice of God; it is not as difficult to recognize as one might believe
- Learn how to 'tune to the voice of the Lord' and tune out other voices of influence by developing your ability to recognize when the Lord is speaking
- Know that God still speaks today. He has never stopped speaking.
- Realize that prayer should not be one-way communication with God; prayer should be dialogue with God
- Identify safeguards for hearing the Lord's voice
- · Class includes an introduction to journaling as a way of communing with God

#### Class Methodology of Teaching:

- 1. Class lectures
- 2. Student interaction
- 3. Reading, textbook assignments
- 4. Biblical and extra-biblical study projects (as assigned)
- 5. Question and answer opportunities

#### **Course Requirements:**

- 1. Participate in classroom discussions and in-class journaling when prompted.
- 2. Any assignments given (homework) *Communion With God,* Mark and Patti Virkler
- 3. Students are required to obtain a journal of some kind to be used in cooperation with this class and beyond.
- 4. Class attendance and punctuality is **required.**
- 5. In case of an absence:
