## **Class Duration:**

• four weeks

### **Course Textbook:**

- *Hell's Toxic Trio* by Ryan LeStrange
- The Bible

## **Course Description:**

Three of the enemy's strongest spirits against the body of Christ are the Jezebel spirit, the Python spirit, and the religious spirit. This class will expose these spirits and identify the characteristics of each one. Students will be given biblical tools to successfully combat and defeat these spirits.

## **Course Goals and Objectives:**

Students will

- realize we are at war against demonic forces, that they can be defeated, and that a believer does not need to fear
- identify each of the three spirits (Jezebel, Python, and religious) and understand how they operate, maneuver, and destroy
- understand the goal of these spirits is to reverse the progress of one's spiritual growth and to break one's faith
- identify specific characteristics of each of the three spirits and learn how they can influence, infiltrate, control, and divide the Church and revival

- be able to recognize and discern when these spirits are present and in operation
- be given biblical tools to successfully combat and defeat these spirits
