Bible Doctrines, A Pentecostal PerspectiveWilliam W. Menzies and Stanley M. Horton

Course Description:

This course of study will survey basic Christian doctrines with special attention given to key terms, concepts, and biblical texts.

Course Objectives and Goals:

To enable the student:

- To recognize the importance of doctrine, a very important part of the Word of God that should be understood
- Be more prepared to "earnestly contend for the faith" Jude 1:3-4; to train students to understand, articulate, and defend basic Christian truths
- To develop a scriptural confidence in what the student believes
- To reach out with the Gospel to those who do not know Christ and be equipped to lead them to a saving knowledge of Him
- To be able to give an explanation for the hope found in Jesus Christ
- To be able to practice holy living "Right living is a result of right believing."
- To be able to recognize incorrect or erroneous doctrine
- To build the student's faith because he/she knows and understands truth about God

Class Methodology of Teaching:

- 1. Class lectures
- 2. Student interaction
- 3. Reading, textbook assignments
- 4. Biblical and extra-biblical study projects (as assigned)
- 5. Question and answer opportunities

Course Requirements:

- 1. Participate in group discussions.
- 2. Outside assignments (homework):
 - a. Continue reading the text of the Old Testament
 - b. Reading the assigned textbook and completing any homework assignments and quizzes given from the book
- 3. Class attendance and punctuality is required.
- 4. In case of an absence:
 - a. **The student** is required to watch the video of the missed lecture before the next class night and take the lecture quiz.
 - b. It is the **student's responsibility** to contact the school office to inquire about any handouts, homework assignments, etc. the student may have missed.
 - c. **The student** is to be current by the next class, keeping pace with the instructor and other students.
