Class Duration:

Course Description:

God is restoring deliverance to the church, but many believers feel intimidated or ill-equipped to cast out demons. Perhaps the only examples they have seen use bizarre, unbiblical, or unhelpful methods. *How to Minister Deliverance* is a course that will help equip and empower the student to step into the ministry of deliverance. This course is designed for any believer who wants to begin or to grow in ministering deliverance.

- walk in authority and the anointing of the Holy Spirit
- learn biblical keys and a practical model for ministering deliverance
- consider specific prayers to use in various situations
- learn how to identify and deal with demonic manifestations
- learn how to minister deliverance in a group setting
- be equipped to train teams in the ministry of deliverance
