Class Description:

This course exposes the faulty foundation and root system of the orphan spirit which is comprised of pride, shame, and fear. This course will serve as a roadmap for students to grow out of orphan-hearted, sinful attitudes and into maturity in Christ with real humility and unwavering courage. Jesus came to reveal God as Father and to deliver us from every soul affliction, and it is only through a revelation of Christ and who we are in Him that we can experience the abundant life He died to give us. Students will be taken on a beautiful journey into the heart of God the Father and will be challenged to walk in their true identity in Christ and to live for God's purpose and pleasure alone.

- complete an in-depth study of mankind's fall in the Garden of Eden and its effect on our flesh's struggle with pride, shame, and fear

- be given biblical tools as a roadmap that will assist them both personally as well as in future ministry settings when dealing with the orphan spirit
