

# PARISH PULPIT ANNOUNCEMENTS & STICKER INSTRUCTIONS

We're here to help you make the most of parish announcements and book donations to ensure your book fair is a success. Here's everything you should know:

#### PARISH PULPIT ANNOUNCEMENTS

We've provided announcements for the three weekends leading up to the book fair. These can be read at the end of each Mass to spread the word and encourage parishioners to support the event.

- Fill In The Dates: Add the dates of your book fair so parents and parishioners know when it's happening.
- Community Events: If you're hosting a specific day or event for the community to attend, include those details in the announcements.
- Parish School-Only Events and Social Growth: If the book fair is just for parish school students, focus on reminding parents and encouraging parishioners to donate books to the school library.

#### **ONLINE BOOK PURCHASES**

Parishioners can also support the school by purchasing books online. When they create an account under your parish school's name to purchase books, the school earns Ave Dollars (rewards to get free books on each purchase). Share this online shopping option in parish bulletins, emails, and on social media to increase participation.

#### **BOOK DONATIONS**

Encourage parishioners to donate \$10 or more to buy books for the school library. Donors can dedicate their gift with a "Donated By" or "In Memory of" sticker to honor themselves or a loved one. We've created ready-to-print stickers for your convenience, which you'll find at the end of this document.

#### MANAGING DONATIONS

- Set up a table after Mass: With your Parish Priest's permission, set up a table with a money pouch and a sign-up sheet to collect donor information.
- Sticker Options: Have printed stickers at the table so donors can fill in their dedication on the spot. Or, record the donor's information and fill in the stickers later.
- Sticker Placement: Once the books arrive, place the sticker on the inside of the front cover.

We've included sticker templates in this packet, ready for you to print. For best results, use <u>Avery 5147</u> <u>name badge sticker paper</u>. If that's unavailable, use regular sticker paper when you print, and cut them out manually after printing.

#### SPREAD THE WORD

Encourage teachers, parents, and parish staff to help promote the book fair and donation opportunities. Use social media, email campaigns, and word of mouth to reach as many people as possible—please refer to the emails titled "Marketing Recap" for more tips and information.
