Charting a path to financial stability

Our support services program is designed to help individuals **chart a path to long-term stability** through access to affordable child care, career readiness resources, job training, financial literacy courses, and information about state and federal resources available to first-time homebuyers.

According to research from the Urban Institute, **children** from stable financial backgrounds are more likely to engage in social activities, build friendships, and develop essential social skills. Path to Financial Stability and Homeownership According to the National Realtors Association, rents

have a tendency to grow 3 % annually while mortgage payments (e.g. 30-year mortgages) are usually fixed.



Financial Literacy

According to the National Foundation for Credit Counseling's 2024 Financial Literacy Survey, a staggering **47% of U.S. adults rate their personal finance knowledge as a "C" or worse**, highlighting a significant gap in financial education.



Soft Skills Training

A study highlighted by the National Institutes of Health found that soft skills training programs significantly improve job-seeking efforts, leading to better employment opportunities and, consequently, financial stability.



Access to Affordable Child Care

Research indicates that when child care is affordable, families experience improved financial well-being. A study by Forry (2009) found that families with access to affordable child care are better able to meet their basic needs, such as obtaining food, saving money, paying bills on time, and reducing debt. According to the Poverty Action Lab, **vocational** training programs that incorporate practical work experience, financial support, and job placement assistance have shown significant positive outcomes for participants and lead to
