MINUTES

The City of Loogootee City Council convened in regular session February 10, 2025, in the meeting room at the City Hall located at 401 JFK Ave, Loogootee, Indiana.

The meeting was called to order with the Pledge to the Flag at 6:20 pm.

CHURCH STREET PARK ISI CHANGE ORDER

A change order for Church Street Park project was requested to add additional electrical options. Dave made a motion to approve the change order, seconded by Mark. All in favor, motion passed.

COUNTRY COURT V PAY APPLICATION #5

Clerk Treasurer requested the Council's approval to pay the latest pay application on the Country Court V project. A motion was made by Carroll, seconded by Jeremy. All in favor, motion carried.

HOUSING DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Joe White from Sullivan Development gave the Council an update on the progress with the housing development possibly coming to the industry park area that the city owns. They stated that they are working on the final phases and that they expect the financial portion to be finished by May. They hope to begin construction in June. No action was needed.


ESSENTIAL BUSINESS
